

Honda Gunners' defence breached in 8-4 loss

The Milton Honda Gunners took an 8-4 decision on the nose against Mississauga Cyclepath in indoor soccer action at Soccer World Two on the weekend.

Gunners came out flat in the contest, said team president Reg Griffin. Mississauga counted five consecutive times in the first half drilling markers in the second, tenth, fifteenth, and twenty-fifth minutes of

the first half. They capped their scoring barrage with a goal in extra time.

Milton rallied with four goals in the second half. In the fourth minute, Paul Vincent slammed the ball home after Kevin Griffin and Trevor Griffin worked it in close.

Two minutes later, Milton narrowed the Mississauga lead to 5-2 when Richard Sewell took an Eric Geldard pass and counted for the

Gunners. Cyclepath notched their sixth goal in the ninth minute and scored again in the 12th minute to put the game out of reach.

The Gunners were not going to be left on the wrong side of a lopsided score however. Geldard booked one home in the 14th minute and John D'Andrea made it 7-4 in the 17th

minute. Kevin Griffin collected assists on both goals and Geldard managed an assist on D'Andrea's mark.

Mississauga popped one in the 20th minute to end the scoring.

"We were flat in the game, no doubt about it," said Gunners' president Reg Griffin.

"We picked up in the second but with 15 players it's hard to get anything going. The players never get used to each other."

Griffin says the team is still looking for talent. Anyone who is interested can attend practices at Erindale College on Mississauga Road on Fridays at 7 p.m. in the main gym.
