Brier regionals held here Dec. 8

The Provincial Division Nine curling playdowns are scheduled for this Friday through Sunday (Dec. 8-10) at Milton Curling Club on Millside Drive.

The playdowns haven't been held in Milton in at least 17 years, said Ken Armstrong of the club. Division Nine includes most of Peel region, Orangeville and Halton region, save Burlington.

Once a team wins a divisional playdown they are eligible for the provincial championship. There are

16 divisionals and those numbers are cut to 10 prior to the Ontario Championship, to be held this year in Chatham.

The winner of the province goes to the Brier, which is the national Championship. The winner of that goes to the Silver Broom World Championship, so it is possible to enter a team of one's choice and play through to the world title round.

John Base, a former provincial finalist and a former World Junior Champion, will be in the tournament

draw. Ron Rowley, three times a provincial qualifier, will also be competing. Rowley is well known locally, though he now curls out of the Chinguacousy Curling Club.

Other locals include Steve Oldford and Bob Fedosa. Both have been curling in town for a number of years. Oldford was the Provincial Schoolboy Champion in 1985.

The divisional playdown features a 16-team double knockout format. The participants are all club champions. Action gets underway about 6:30 p.m. Friday, December 8. Saturday action is expected to go all day from 9 a.m. through 10 p.m. The curlers take to the ice at 9 a.m. again Sunday, with the finals expected to start about 2 p.m.

A crowd of between 200 and 300 is expected. Everyone is welcome and there is no admission charge.

In the final Milton took a 2-0 lead into the second period on goals by Burne from Walsh and Denich and Brown from Dave Hassell.

Schomberg replied with three quick goals and Milton dug in, tied it when Denich popped one from a Noon pass.

Schomberg popped two un-

answered goals in the third period, although Milton did miss several opportunities to reply.

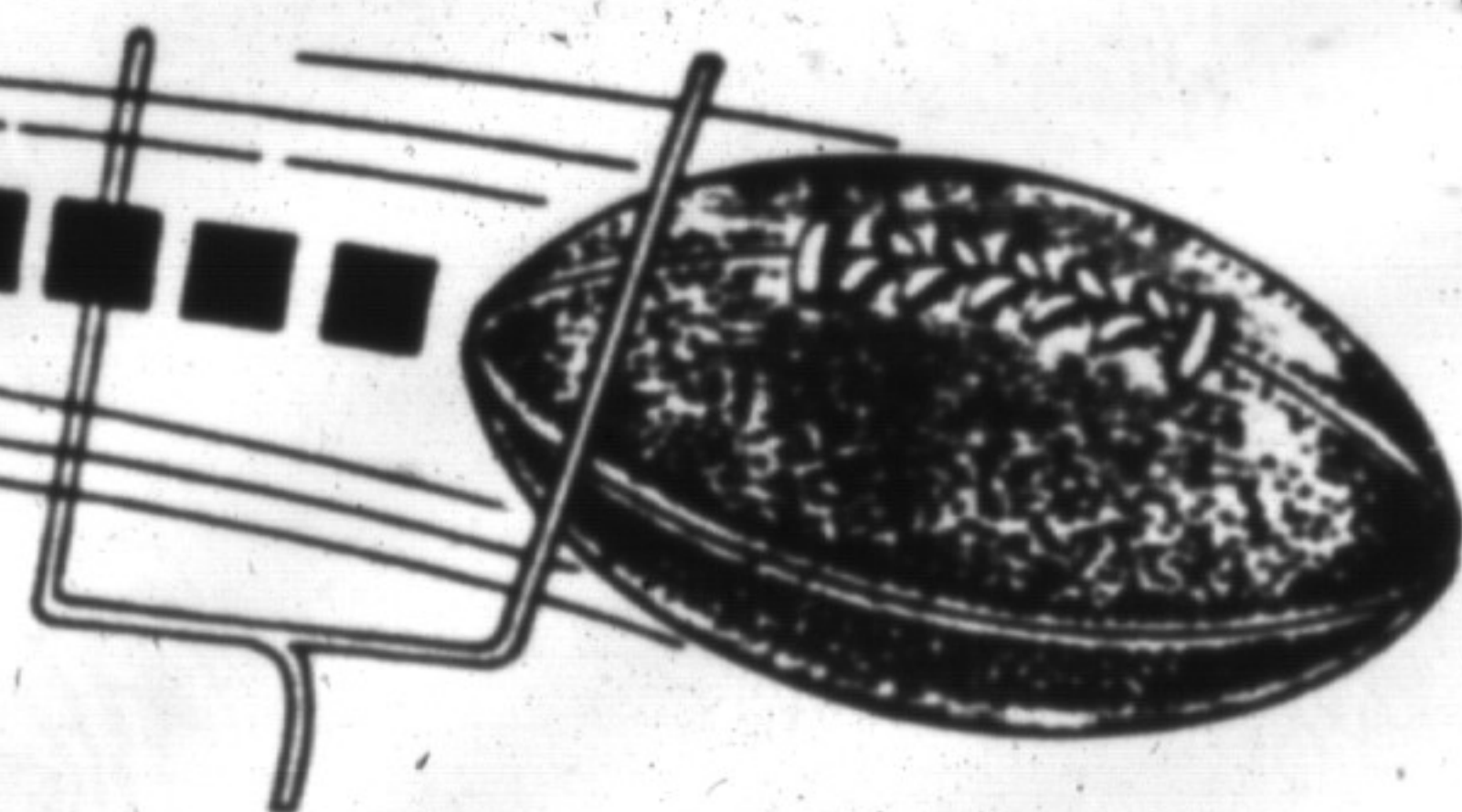


Special awards
