

Vandalism on the rise

Each day, more than 10 complaints of property vandalism are received by Halton Regional Police.

One such occurrence took place in Acton on Saturday, Feb. 17 at 2:57 a.m. An Acton citizen heard glass smashing at the Flightline Store, West Warehouse, a division of the old Hyde House at 7-11 Mill St. The witness then noticed two youths running eastbound on Mill Street away from the store. Although no entry or theft occurred, damage of a plate glass window was estimated at \$1,500.

Halton Police are seeking help in finding the identity of these two culprits. Any citizen can help, by reporting any incidents to the police or by calling Crime Stoppers with the names of people responsible.

Stolen goods, robbery suspects found

Two men have been arrested in connection with two recent break-ins in Milton.

Equipment, supplies and cash valued at about \$3,600 were stolen from Patene Building Supplies Ltd. and a Petro Canada service station, both on Trafalgar Road North, sometime between February 17 and 19.

After obtaining a search warrant, Halton Regional Police say they found the stolen property February 19 in a room at the Fifth Wheel Truck Stop where the suspects were staying. Most of the equipment and money were recovered.

Charged with two counts of break, enter and theft are a 19-year-old suspect who resides in Milton and a 21-year-old man of no fixed address. The men will appear in provincial
