## Sap is running at Mountsberg and Crawford Lake

The sap is flowing, and the age-old tradition of maple syrup production in Ontario is again underway.

Maple syrup production marks one of the earliest and most resourceful uses of the environment by man, and this treasured, annual ritual can be enjoyed by people at two Halton conservation areas from Sunday, Mar. 4, to Monday, Apr. 16.

This opportunity to shake the winter blues happens in The Maple Syrup Time program at Mountsberg Conservation Area, and the Thanks to the Maple Season program at the Crawford Lake Indian Village. They operate weekends and holidays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and daily during the winter break from March 12-16.

Mountsberg Conservation Area has an extensive sugar bush, the site of syrup making demonstrations using methods ranging from pioneer

to modern. Riding in horse drawn wagons, visitors are taken to the sugar bush, which includes a sugar house with a wood-fueled evaporator and a candy house where the maple sugar is made. As long as

there is snow, delicious maple taffy is made by pouring hot syrup over it.

At Crawford Lake, maple sugar making takes place mainly in the pre-historic Indian Village, where

the Thanks to the Maple celebration held a special importance in the Indian calendar. Visitors learn how the natives discovered 'sweet water' and turned it into maple sugar. Available in this program are village tours, and

hiking opportunities in the forest and the boardwalk surrounding the lake.

Paying the \$6 per car admission at one of the parks grants you entry to the other park on the same day.

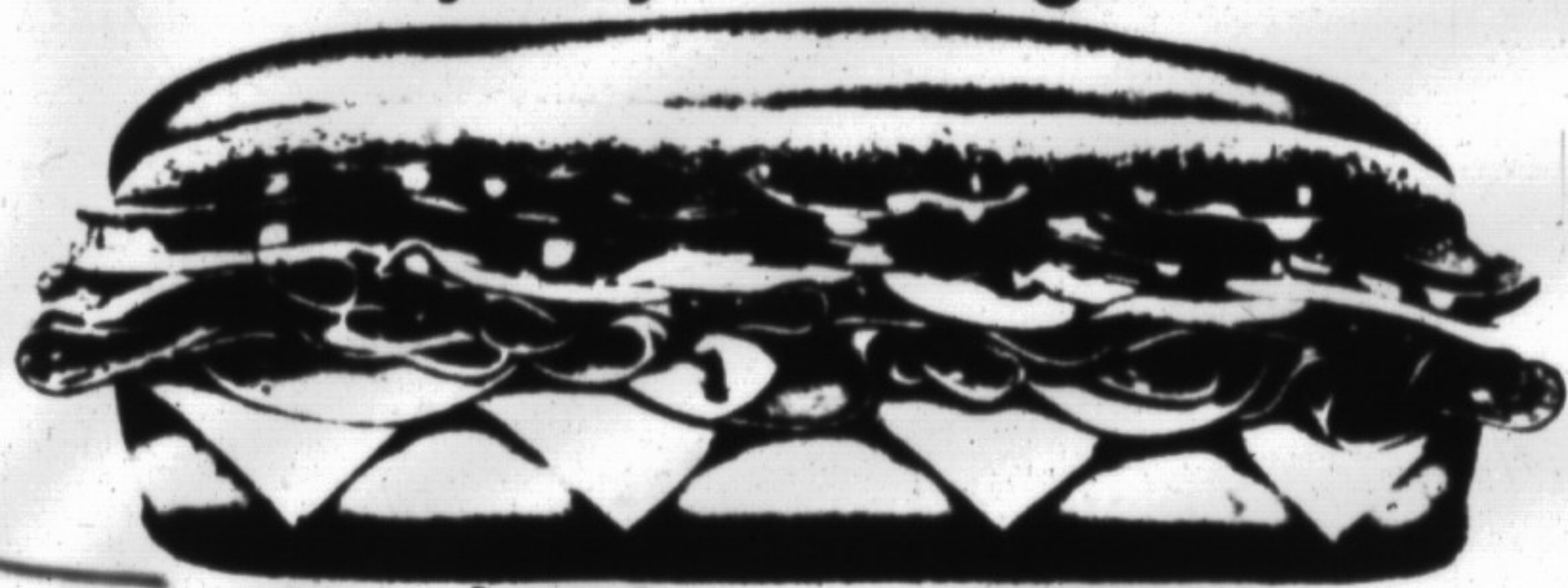

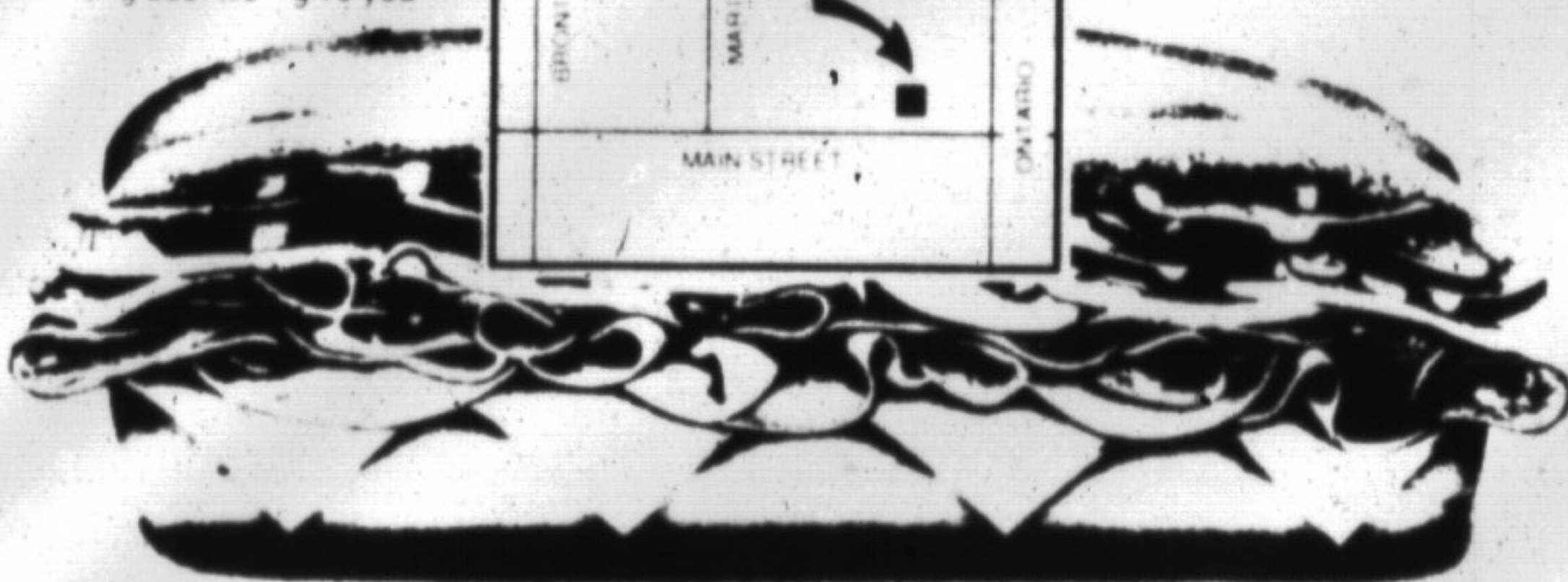

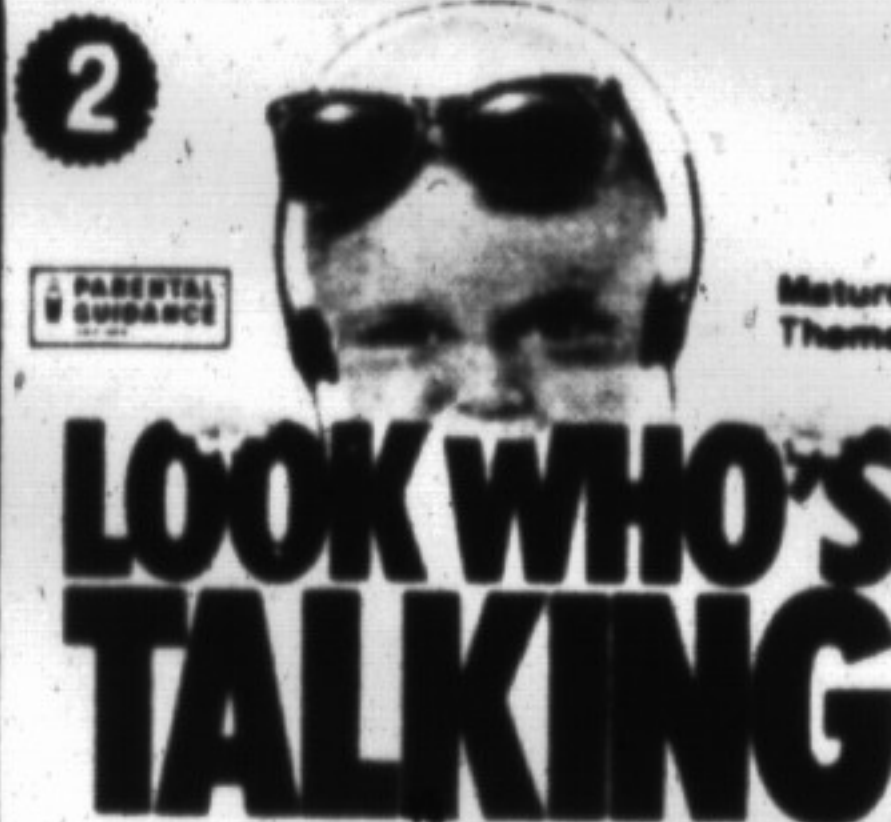
