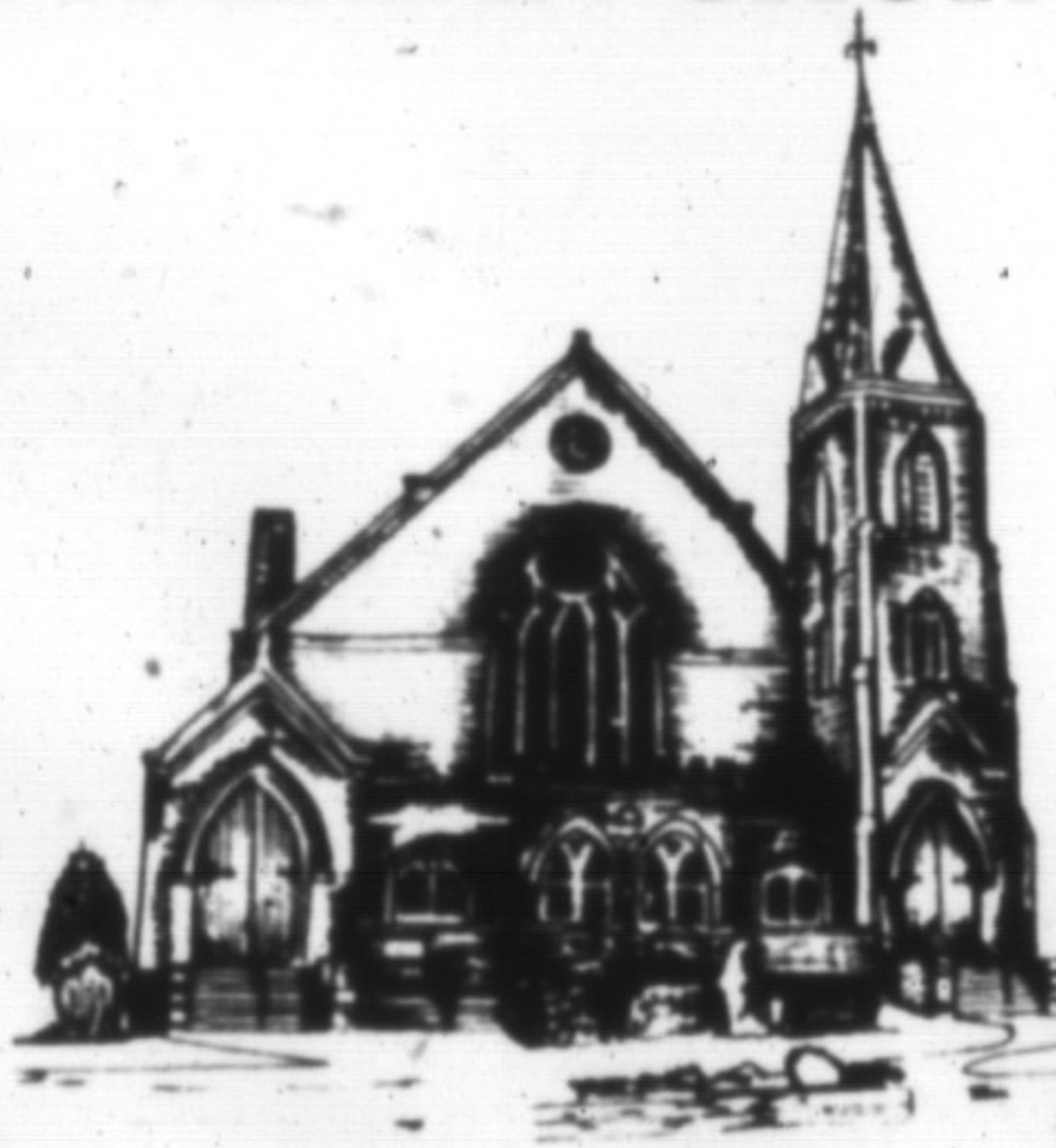

Presbyterians built this classic church in 1890. The property was purchased from W.L.P. Eager, who owned the building seen next to the church. Contractor John Hunter built this building at a cost of \$14,000. An addition at the rear dates from

1894. This was not the original meeting place for the Presbyterians. They built the first Protestant church in town, further west on Main Street in 1846.
