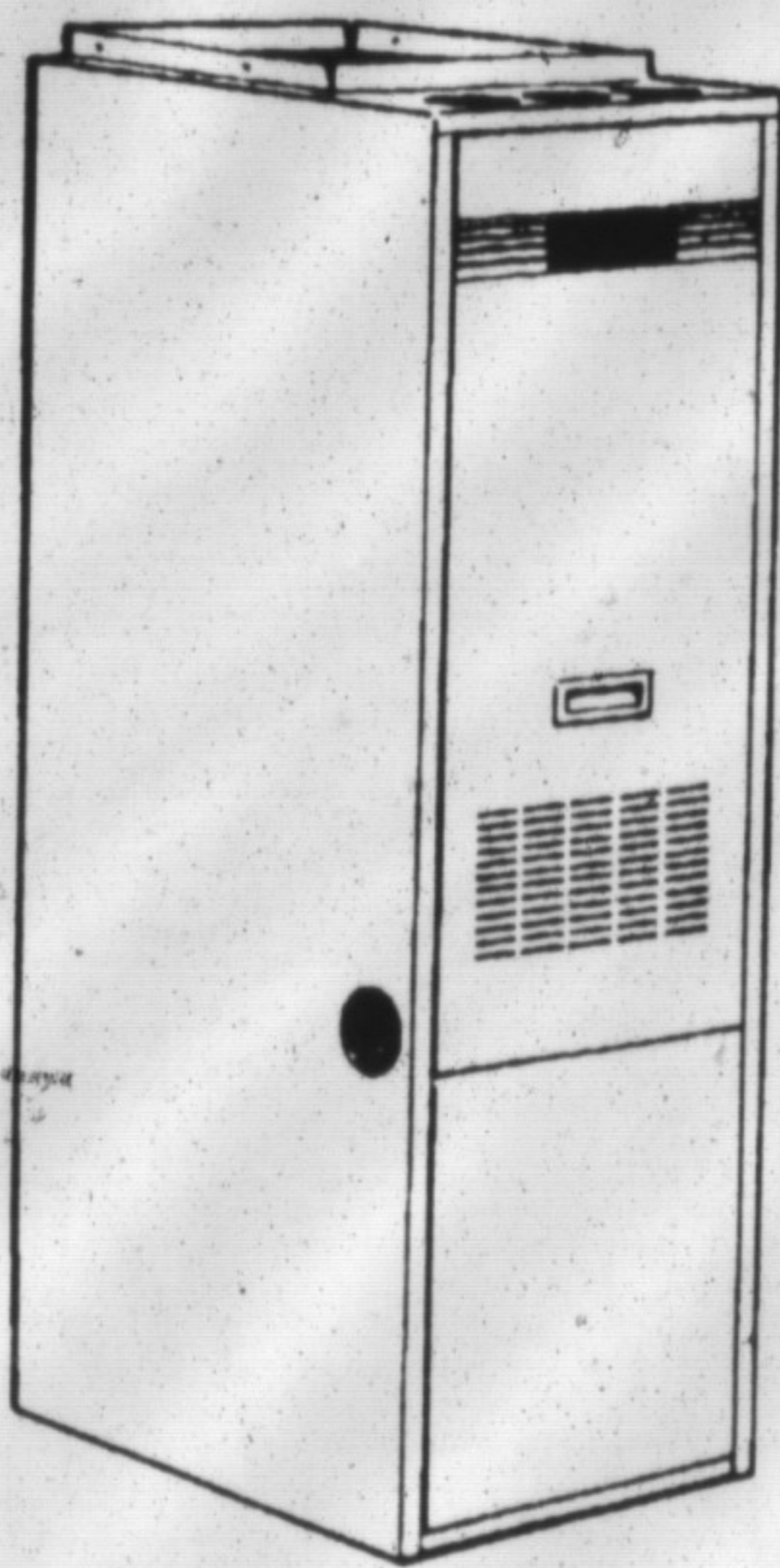

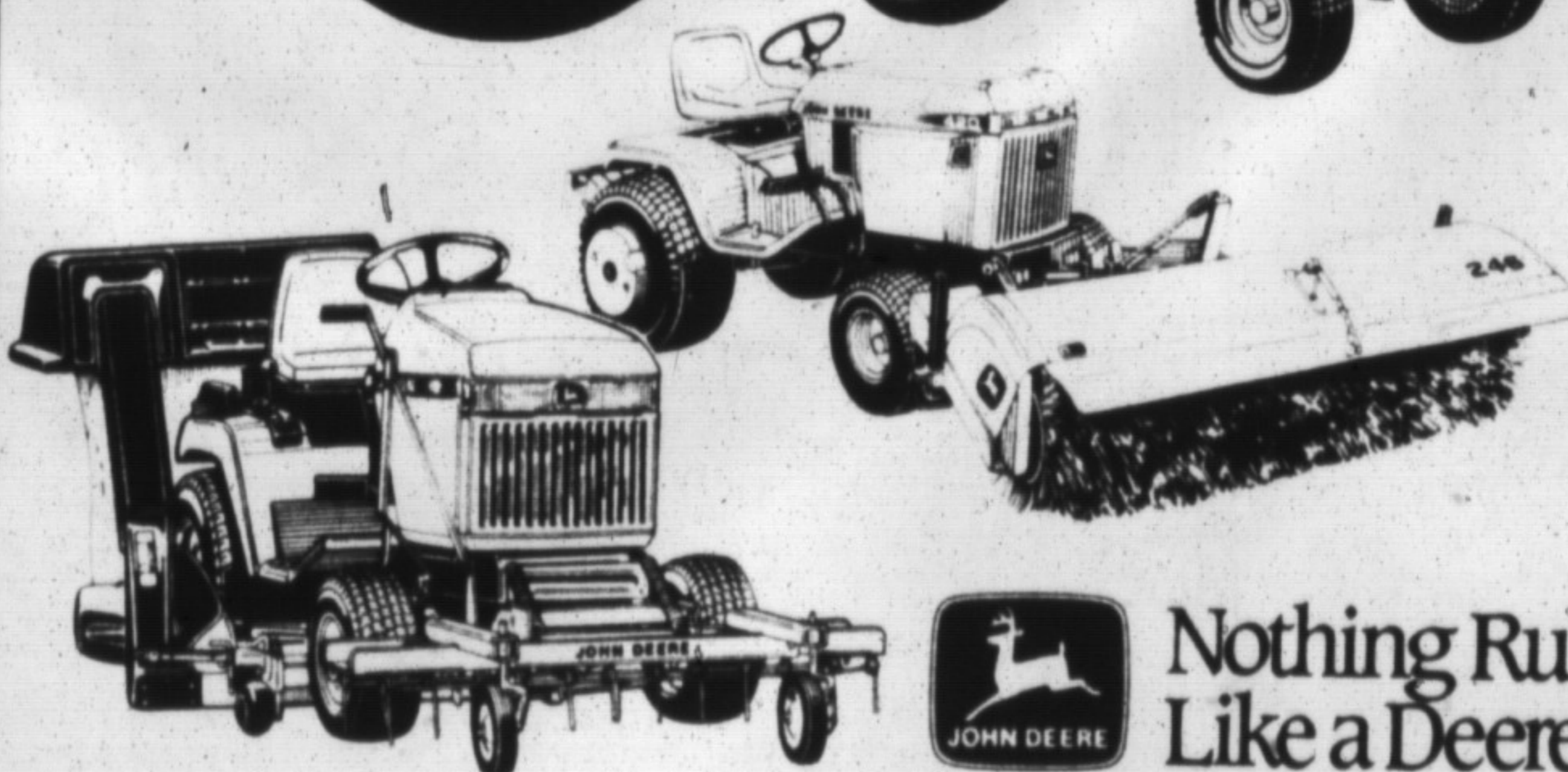
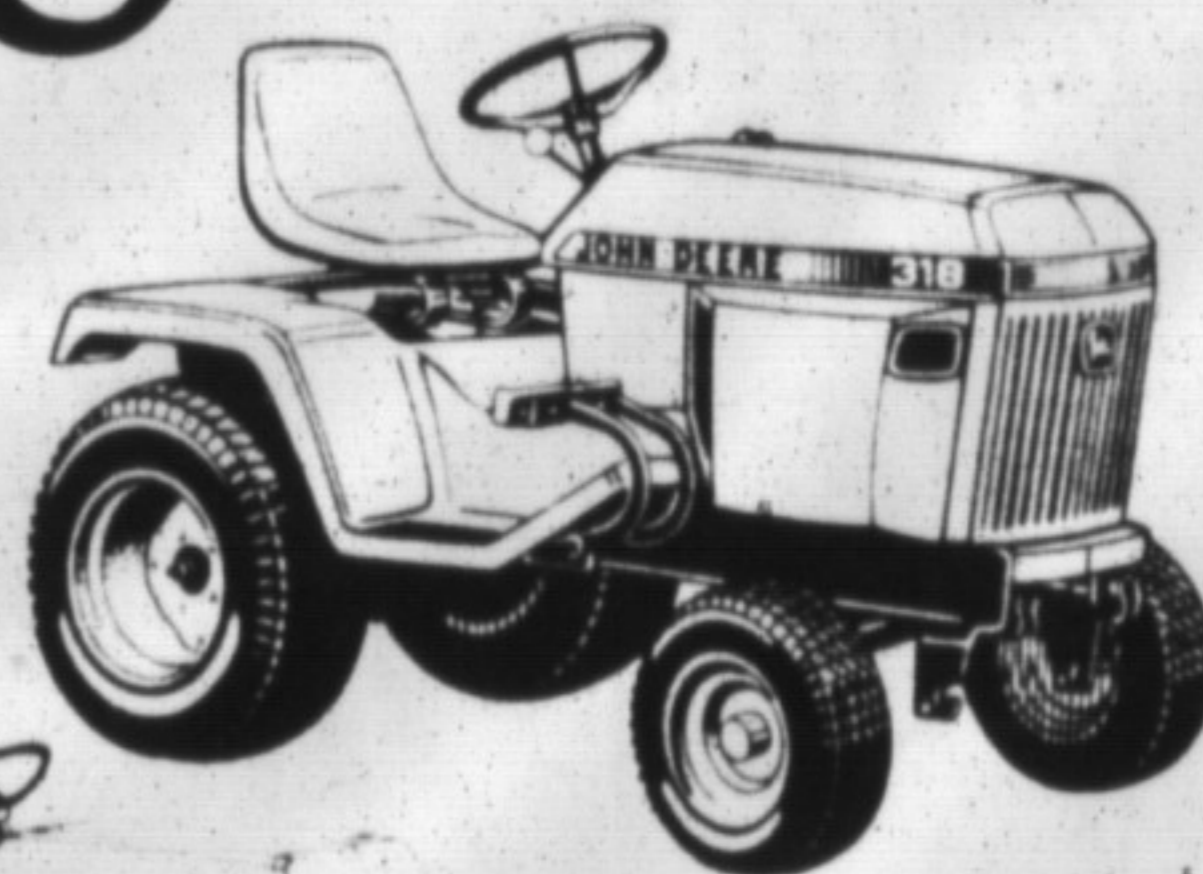

3. Inside the furnace compartment, attached to either the bottom or side panels, is a label with a model and serial number on it.
4. Check for a model number beginning with CGF or CGH followed by 050, 080, or 105.
Example: CGF050N.
5. Check for serial numbers beginning with H335 through H540. **Example: H33712345.**
6. If your furnace has both the model and serial numbers within the described sequence, you are eligible for a heat exchanger upgrade and lifetime warranty.
**Example: CGF050N H33712345.
 CGH050N H33712345**
7. Replace the front panel of the furnace cabinet and call this toll-free number, 1-800-668-0246, before April 1, 1990 to request the free upgrade and lifetime warranty. Be prepared to give your name, address, postal code and the model and serial numbers of your furnace.
