Temagami Action Coalition opposed logging activities in a wilderness triangle located north of Sudbury and North Bay.

They say the logging practices in Temagami — which they call the last accessible wilderness area in eastern Canada — are disrupting the natural environment and will reduce or eliminate recreation, as well as other activities.

The coalition, based at the University of Guelph, is also lobbying the provincial government to put an end to construction of roads providing

access to the area's forests.

Temagami is part of a 4,000 square-mile area which has been the homeland of the Deep Water People for 6,000 years. The natives have been in legal battles with Ontario over claims to the land.

Meanwhile, Halton Hills environmental group Protect Our Water and Environmental Resources (POWER) demonstrated against proposed land-fill sites on the Niagara Escarpment.

"As well as protecting the natural environment, this would protect groundwater," said Barbara Halsall of POWER.

"Uncontaminated groundwater is an increasingly scarce resource on this planet."

The environmental groups' demonstration at the museum coincided with the official ceremony to name the Niagara Escarpment a biosphere reserve.
