Green army fighting for recycling at Baldwin school

To many people the term 'Green Revolution' might sound like an invasion from outer space. It is an invasion but one aimed at being environment friendly.

At Robert Baldwin School, two Grade 5 classes have formed a 'green army' of sorts to increase environmental awareness at the school.

The classes are divided into groups and each group is responsible for certain activities to help the school cut down on waste. The groups cover energy waste, spraying, classroom rules, tree cutting, environmental awareness, toxic waste, food waste, littering and two recycling groups.

According to Tom Martin, one of the teachers of the classes, the idea to start the school in a 'Green Up' program came to him after he attended a conference held by the North York Board of Education. He and his students have been working on the project for a few months now.

The groups have undertaken such works as trying to get family and school to reduce litter, food waste and the use of toxins. A group is trying to get recycling blue boxes for paper. Only residents are allowed to receive blue boxes free of charge and the students are trying to get the money to buy boxes for the school. The tree cutting group is holding fund raisers to buy trees and protect them from being cut.

Also planned are mass student projects like "pitch in week" in which all the students will help to clean the school yard, and a "litter-less lunch" from which the students will begin to start a compost pile to help fertilize the new trees.

Mr. Martin says the children are really "steamed up" by the inactivity of most people in the movement toward an environmentally friendly world.

"They probably feel this way, he said, because they haven't developed an adult's cynicism yet, and that this program is also helping them by giving them a dose of reality."
