Flowers can grow on trees, house and garden plants, shrubs, grasses and weeds and they come in all shapes, sizes and colours. Some smell better than others.

According to this book, the only purpose for flowers is to produce fruits that contain seeds. A description of varied fruits and seeds is included.

If You Were an Ant by S.J. Calder is part of a series of nature books. (The library also has If You Were A Fish and If You Were a Bird).

We follow the tiny creature into its nest. It helps to groom and feed the queen, the largest ant. We take a look at the growth stages of the ant and its body parts.

Ants' strength

It has been a long time since I studied ants and it was interesting to be reminded that they smell, touch, taste and hear through their anten-

We all know how strong these insects are. They can carry loads 10 to 50 times heavier than themselves. At the end of the book, instructions are

provided for making an ant farm. In the children's department at the library, you'll also come across the Life Cycle series of 11 books, one of which is The Life Cycle of a Rabbit by John Williams.

It covers every aspect of a rabbit's life in easy-to-understand language with full-page, colour illustrations. Did you know that the mother rabbit uses its own fur to build a nest for its babies?


