

## Life without a car can be difficult

Will you help build the habit of helping in Milton? Volunteers are needed to fill a variety of positions, including the following:

**Drivers:** If you had to get to an important appointment but had no car, what would you do? Many people in our community face this difficulty regularly. If you have ever tried to get anywhere outside of Milton without a car, you know how limited your options are. Many people cannot get to important medical appointments, or even to work, without the help of volunteer drivers. A number of local agencies are always looking for people to drive members, clients, patients, to appointments throughout Halton and Peel counties, as well as to Toronto and Hamilton. Have you several hours even once a week that you could offer to your neighbours who can't get around without your help?



**Administrative and clerical support:** A number of local agencies are looking for clerical and administrative help with a variety of projects. Some of this work can be done at a volunteer's home. Other work must be done in an agency office. Time required is variable, and work can fit into the volunteer's schedule. If you would like to develop, refine, or maintain clerical and administrative skills, and have even two hours a week to offer, your help would be greatly appreciated.

**Museum volunteers:** Are you interested in Halton's history? Would you like to learn more about it and help others do the same? People who can do research or would like to learn how, are among the volunteers being sought by a local museum.

**Canvassers:** A local non-profit agency is still looking for volunteers who can offer three hours one night early in May for a house-to-house canvassing campaign.

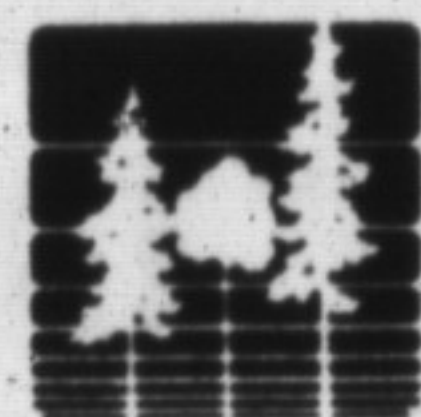
**Help at bingo and on outings:** Volunteers are needed to help at weekly bingo at a seniors' residence. The time involved is from 9 to 10:30 a.m. Wednesdays. Volunteers will help staff run bingo and assist seniors. The same person or another volunteer is being sought to participate in country drives with seniors and staff. Time involved is from 1 to 3 p.m. Wednesdays.

**Bookmobile volunteers:** Volunteers are being sought to deliver books from the library to isolated and shut-in individuals. Time involved is minimal, and deliveries can be made according to the volunteer's schedule.

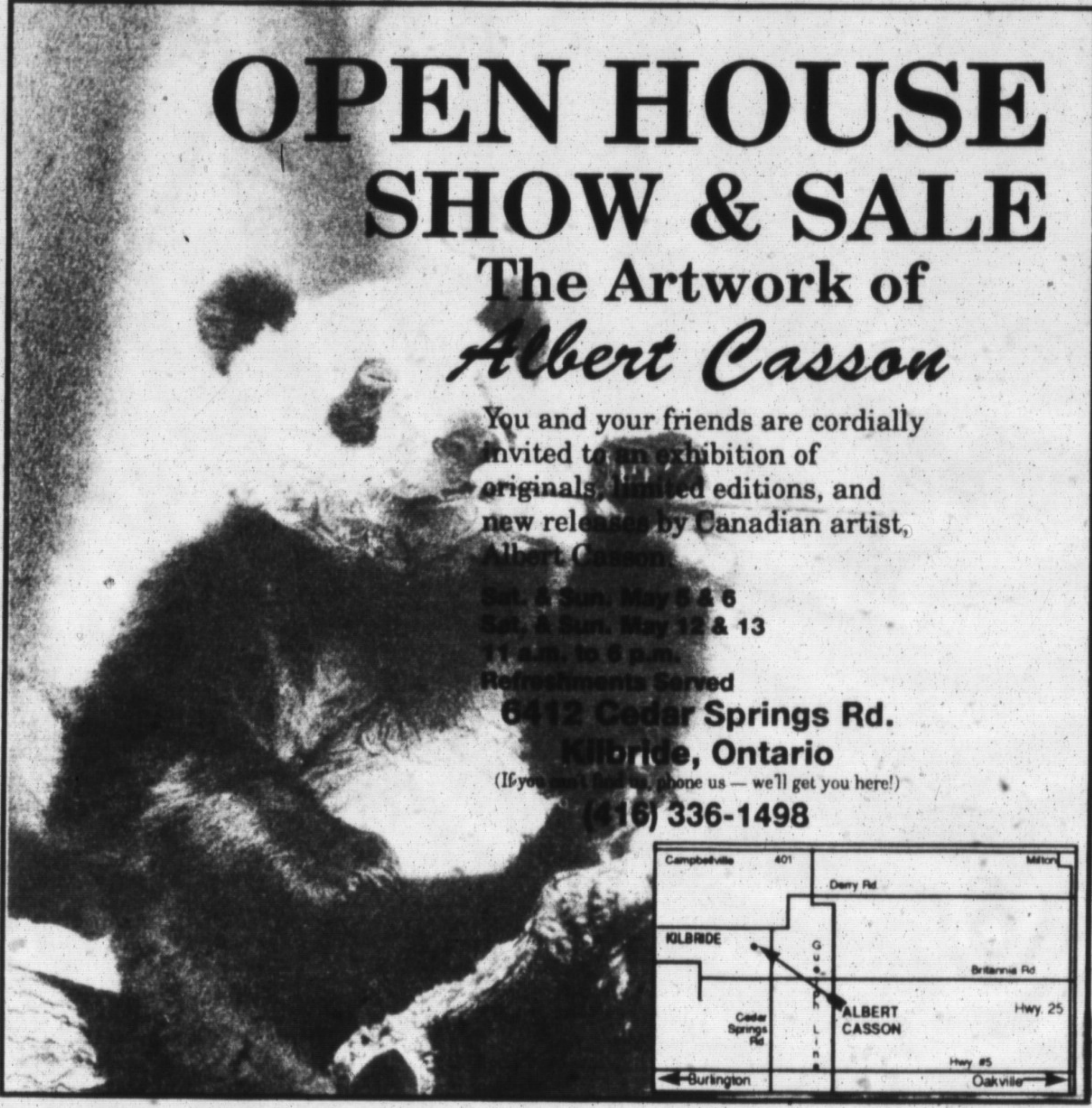

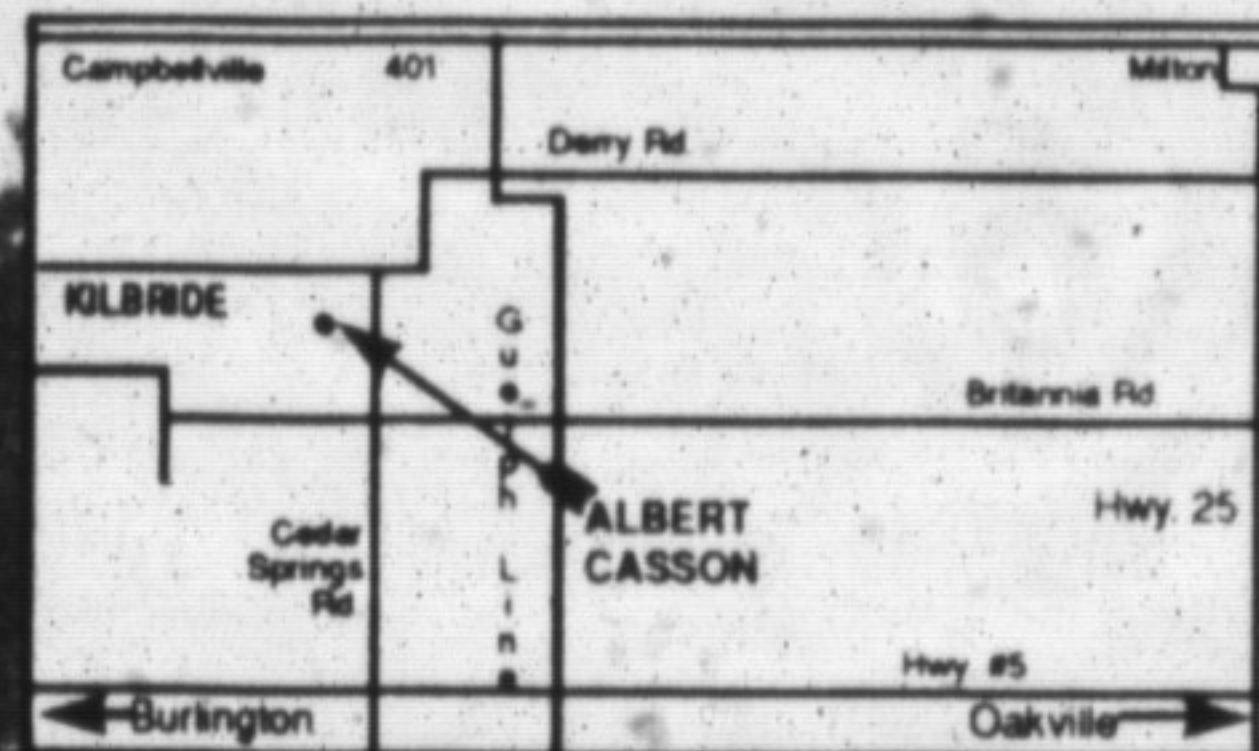

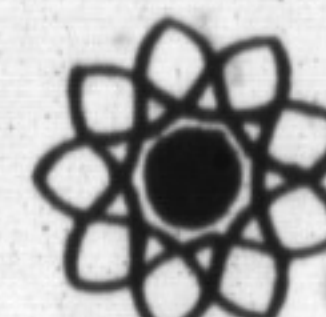
