Dog Excrement on Private & Public Property.
Pursuant to Town of Milton By-law No. 38-83, no person who owns, harbours or possesses any dog shall allow it to trespass on private property, even when on a leash, and shall clean up any excrement deposited by their dog. A fine can be imposed for contravention of this By-law.

Dogs Running at Large

Pursuant to Milton By-law Nos. 126-74, a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in any place other than the premises of the owner of the dog and not under the control of any person. Dogs running at large are often responsible for damages to other property and animal life for which the owner is held responsible. A fine can be imposed for contravention of the By-laws.

Dog Tags

Pursuant to Milton By-law No. 88-74, as amended, the owner or harbourer of any dog acquired after January 1st in any given year, is required to obtain a dog licence for the current year. Licences are now on sale at the Town Hall, Victoria Park Square, and may also be obtained by direct mail.
All violations should be directed to the attention of the Oakville Humane Society at 845-1551 or Mr. Wm. Bamford, By-law Enforcement officer for the Town of Milton at 878-7211, Ext. 157.

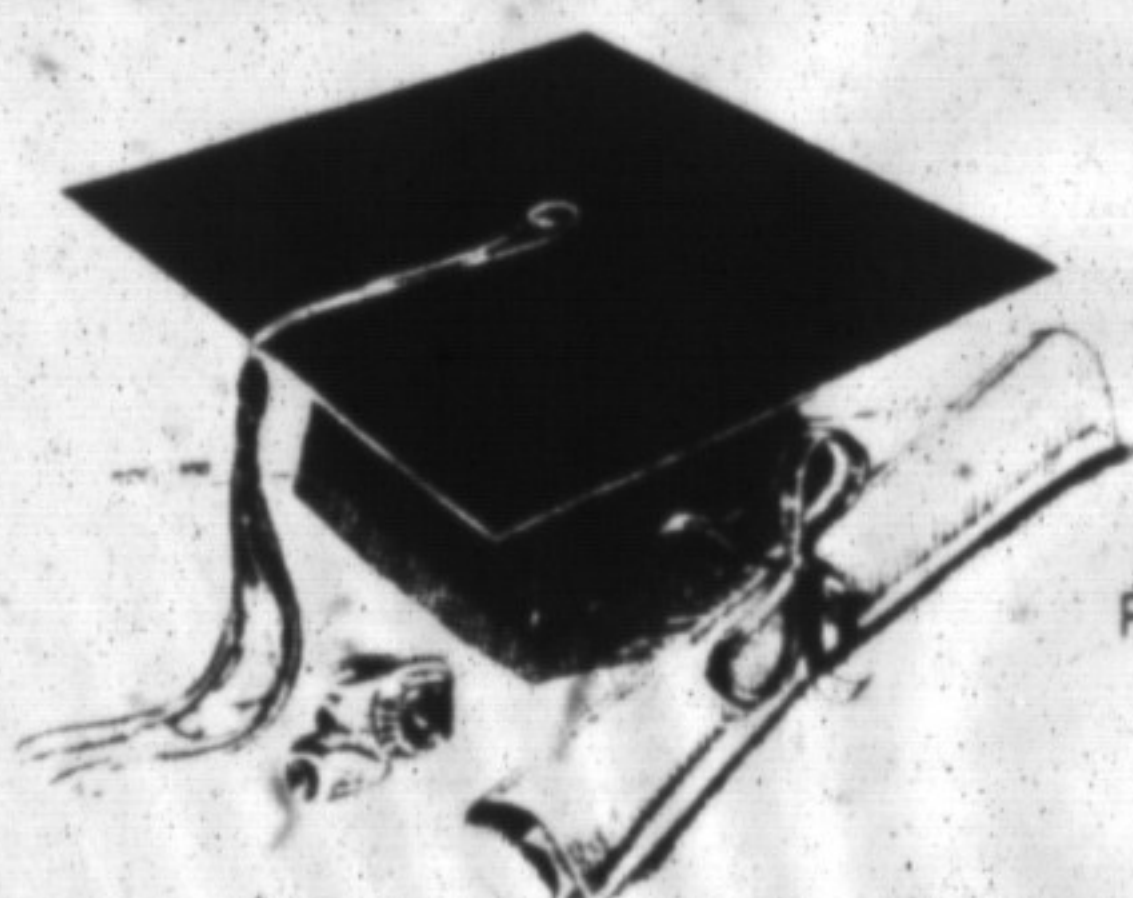
