## Neat Touch has winning touch

Neat Touch had the winning touch on track in the \$115,100 Mohawk Pacing Series Final at Mohawk Raceway Sunday night as Doug Brown guided the sophomore son of Panorama to a handy 1:56.1 victory over a sloppy track.

For trainer Rheel Bourgeois and owner Nick Barbieri of Woodbridge the win was especially nice, because the tandem were shut out of the winner's circle the previous year.

Bourgeois trained four horses that started in the 1989 Mohawk Pacing Series; two of them were owned by

Barbieri but not one of the four could stop Topnotcher from pacing to a 1:53.3 stakes and track record victory for driver Doug Brown.

So for the second consecutive year Brown was back in the winner's circle for the Mohawk Pacing Series but this time he was on side with Bourgeois and Barbieri.

Neat Touch didn't get away well from the starting gate. Two horses, In Trouble and Solitude, both broke stride leaving the gate. "I wasn't too concerned about him not getting away well," said driver Doug Brown, "he's got lots of energy and he's good from off the pace as well."

However, trainer Bourgeois was concerned.

"Usually he leaves so well and tonight I was a little concerned when he was off the pace until I saw the quick half."

Global Assault and driver Bill Gale charged out for the early command and set the tone for most of the mile, clocking fractions of 27.3 for the opening quarter, 56.1 for the half and 1:26 at the three quarter mile station.

Neat Touch sat fifth until the head of the stretch while Brown pulled him out to move into striking position.

In mid-stretch Neat Touch overtook Global Assault to assume command and stop the teletimer in

1:56.1, by two lengths the best on this night. Dak, with trainer-driver Roger Mayotte on board, closed for second and Global Assault held on for third.

This was the first time that Brown had driven Neat Touch, who's small in stature but mighty in spirit.

"I didn't think they would go as fast as they did," said Brown, "I had to work on him because he does get lazy."

Barbieri purchased Neat Touch last September from Christine Gallagher, of Northfield, Ohio for \$60,000. She felt the horse had stakes potential but was not able to travel with the animal.

The win was the third in 14 starts and boosted his season's income to \$96,859. Neat Touch is eligible for the Burlington Pacing Stakes and the North America Cup.

### Take A Look

Nine consecutive wins and still going strong. Ace pacing veteran Take A Look, an eight-year-old son of Most Happy Fella, paced to his ninth win in a row on the Ontario Jockey Club circuit.

The seemingly invincible pacer who combines stallion duties with a racing career had to work hard on Sunday to defeat My Guru in 1:55.7 for trainer-driver Roger Mayotte.

The win was his 11th in 15 starts and he now has a lifetime earnings of \$982,124, rapidly closing on the million dollar mark.

Harness racing moves to Greenwood Raceway, Monday, May 28 for the \$10-million summer stakes season. Racing will be conducted Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays with a 7:30 start each night.

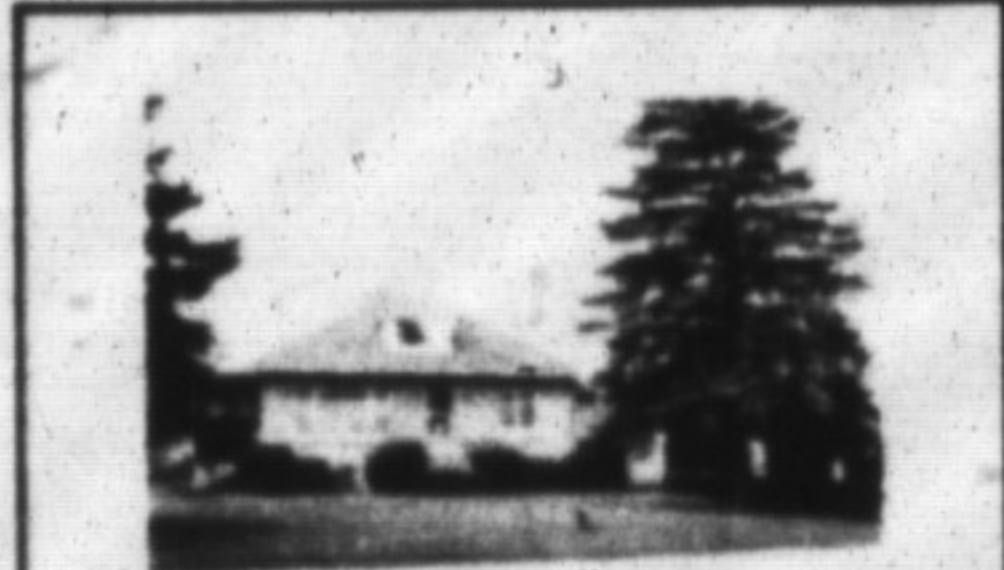

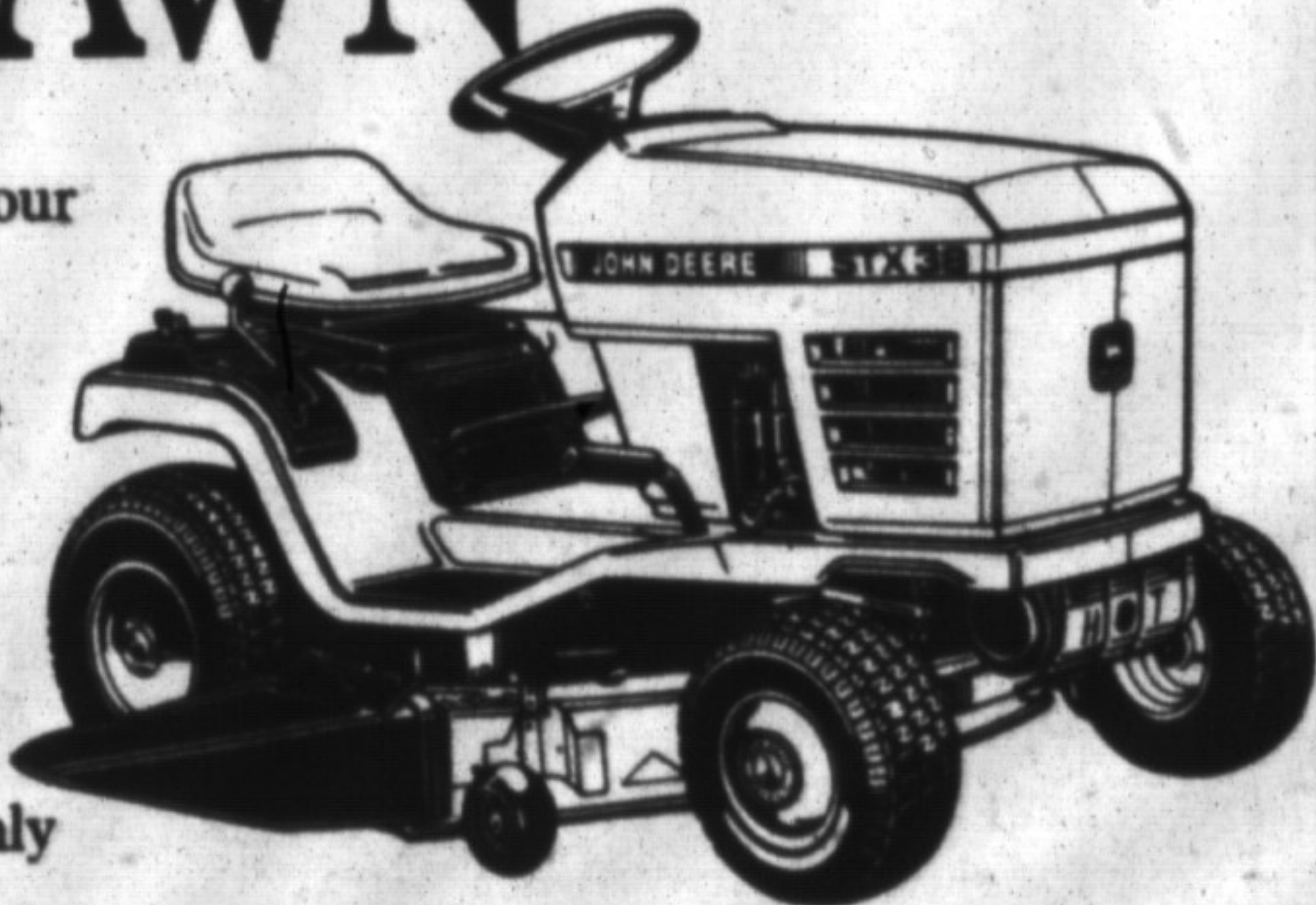
