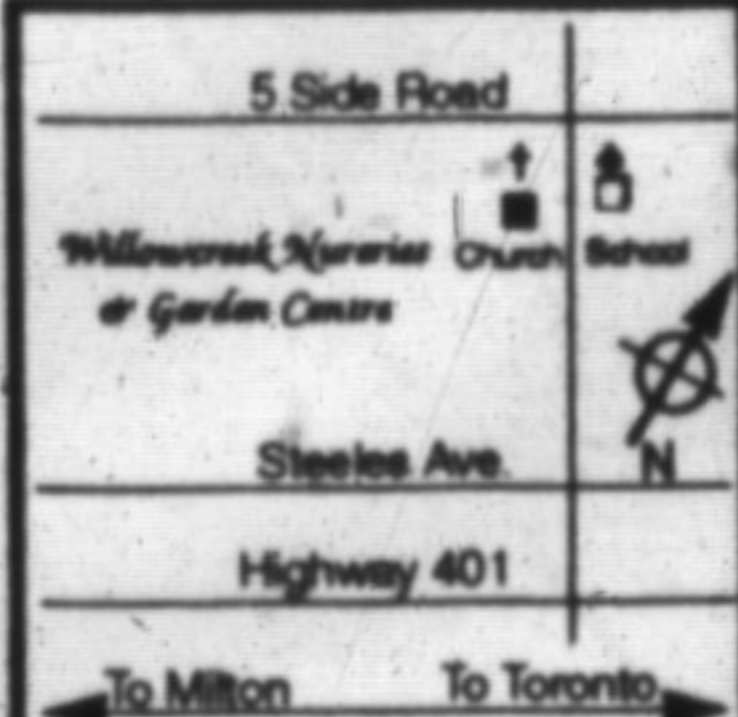
A large number of P.W. Merry School graduates attended a 25-year reunion of students who went to Montclair School in Oakville, Saturday.
