

# It's a week for senior awareness

Next week has been dedicated to seniors and that means special events and deals including free Milton Transit rides, a 25-cent breakfast and 65-cent admission to the Ontario Agricultural Museum.

Seniors' Awareness Week runs from June 10-16 and includes activities at Milton Mall that begin with the bargain continental breakfast at 8:30 Monday morning in front of the mall administration office. That afternoon there will be a Through Other Eyes Workshop conducted at the mall.

The workshop involves a simulation exercise that limits participants' abilities, allowing them to experience life as an older person.

Other activities at the mall include a fitness demonstration, free blood pressure clinics, seniors' tea on Thursday afternoon followed by a performance of the Hand Bell Choir and much more. Information Milton can provide details on events at 875-INFO.

The Agricultural Museum is holding Seniors' Days, offering a 65-cent admission charge and events geared to seniors. There are already more than 1,000 seniors booked to visit during that week on bus tours. Those buses will be taking the seniors to Springridge Farm for lunch. A story in Wednesday's *Champion* indicated there would be a shuttle bus service from the museum to the pick-your-own strawberry farm, however that will not be available.

Halton Centennial Manor will hold an open house on Wednesday from 2-4 p.m. and from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. Refreshments will be provided as well as information. The home for the aged on Ontario Street has expanded its programs to bring community members into the facility and this aspect of services will be among those promoted.

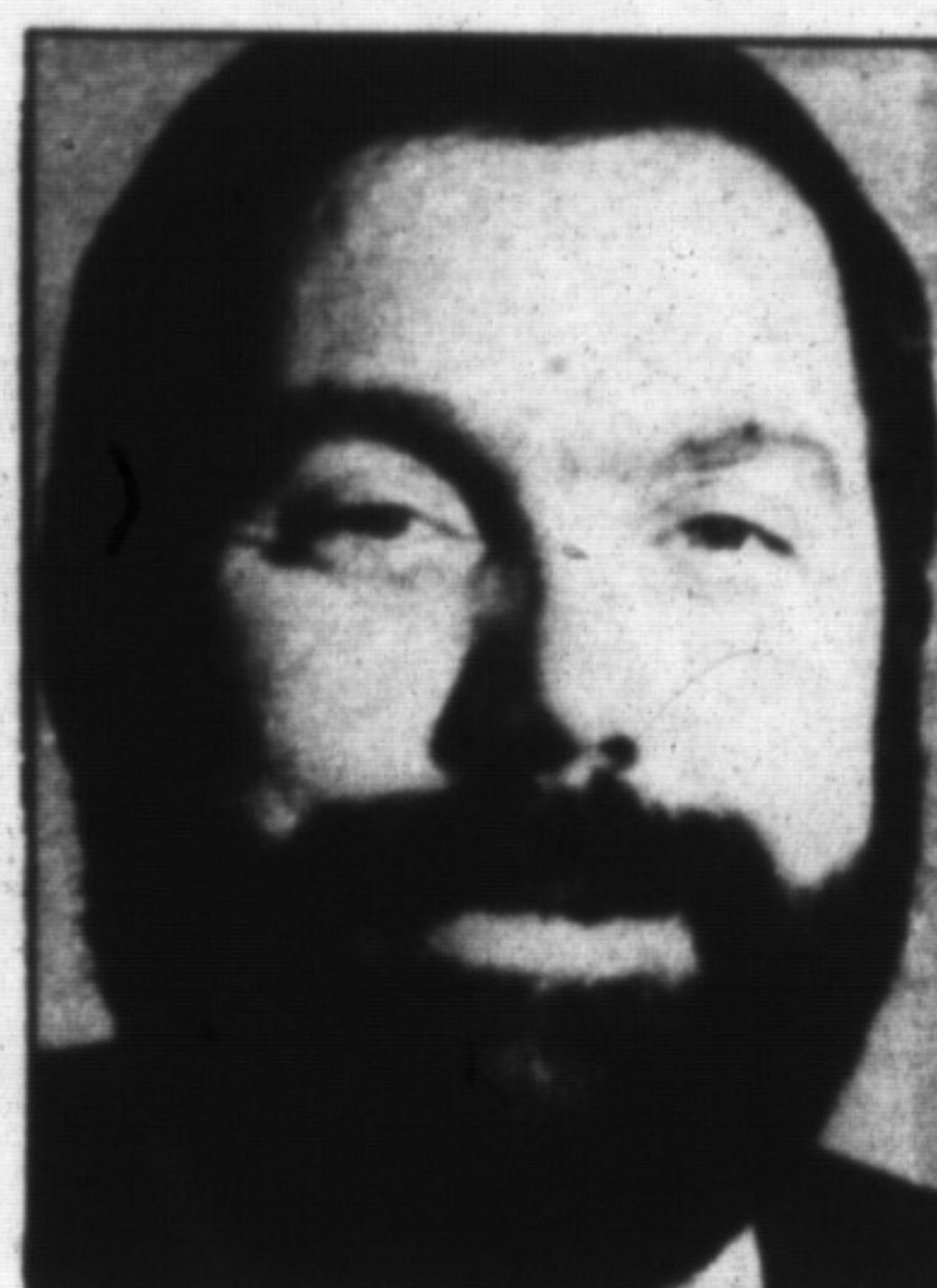
Information will also be available at a booth in the mall all week related to services for seniors and their families.

## Election soon? They're ready

Ontario Premier David Peterson is preparing to go the polls and area hopefuls are making sure they are ready when the call comes.

Wednesday night Halton North incumbent Walt Elliot was acclaimed as the Liberal candidate for the riding in the next election. Tuesday night Progressive Conservative Dave Whiting of Halton Hills was unchallenged in his bid to carry the Tory banner.

Mr. Elliot said recently Premier Peterson told his government, "I want to be able to call an election for any reason. I don't want to not be able to call one if some of you guys are not ready."

An election can't come soon enough for Mr. Elliot. He

has been pushing for it in recent months, despite the fact the Liberal mandate is good until 1992.

Mr. Whiting, 42, locked horns with Mr. Elliot, 57, in the last provincial election. Mr. Whiting is a Halton Hills real estate agent and shopkeeper. Mr. Elliot is a former high school math teacher.

In Halton Centre, the riding which nets eastern and southern portions of rural Milton, incumbent Liberal Barbara Sullivan was acclaimed Monday night.

The guest speaker at the event was Sean Conway, the Minister of Education. He described Mrs. Sullivan as "one of the hardest working members of the Legislature."

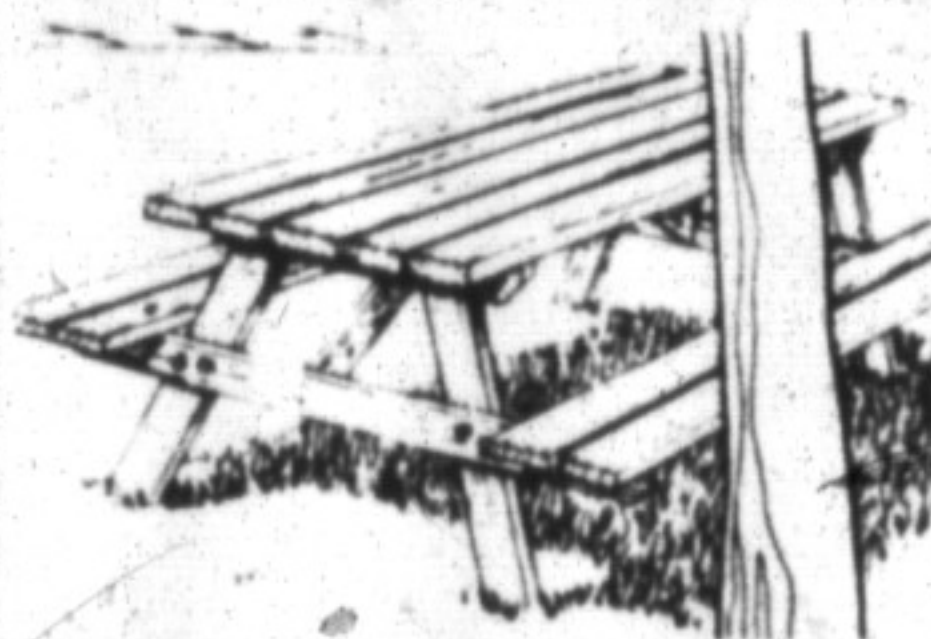

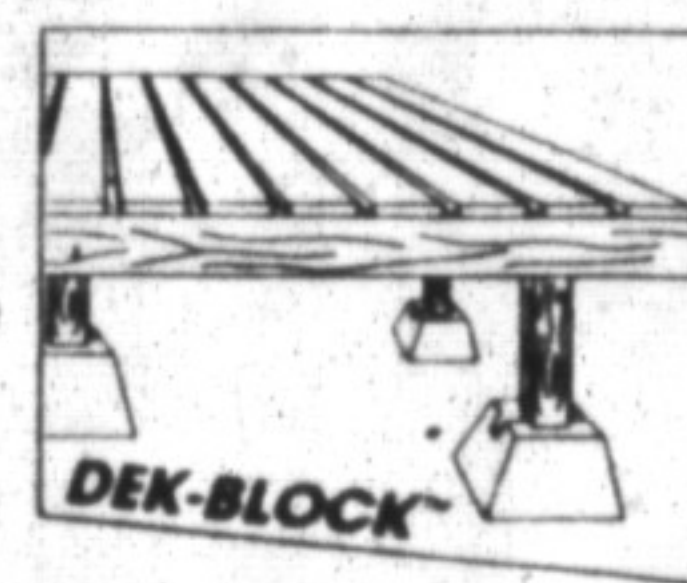
