Arts camp offered in Oakville

An arts summer day camp sponsored by the Oakville Suzuki Association will be run at White Oaks High School from July 16-20 and 23-27.

Children from Peel and Halton are welcome to participate, whether they have been working by Suzuki or by more traditional music instruction methods. The camp will encourage all children in their study of music and drama. It will also allow beginners to try out an instrument of their choice.

Classes are offered in violin, viola, cello, piano, flute, recorder, voice, other wind instruments and guitar. Instruction will be given daily, both in private and in a group. As well as participating in classes, children can experience a variety of other activities including creative drama, singing, recreational sports, crafts and orchestra.

There will be a daiy noon concert given by students and faculty and recrea-

tional swimming at the end of the day.

Three programs are offered; the junior program for children aged 4-6, the regular Preforming Arts camp for intermediates 7-9 and senior for ages 10-14. A special chamber music camp will be offered for three hours every afternoon for advanced students.
