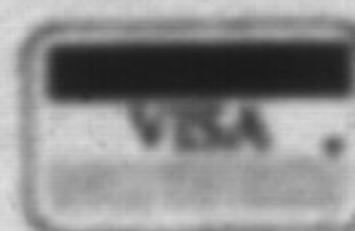

- Commercial Street at Pine Street

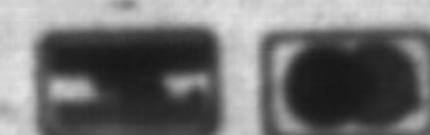
