

Second World War vet Jimmy Downs dies at 66

James A. Downs of Milton died unexpectedly in his sleep at his home June 9. He was 66.
 Son of the late Floyd A. Downs and Eva Downs, he was born in Hornby April 2, 1924.
 Mr. Downs spent all his life in the Hornby and Milton area. Jimmie, as he was known, worked with his father in the family threshing business — a practice the Downs name

became identified with.
 A veteran of World War II, he married Vera Varley on June 22, 1946.
 Later, in 1948, he and his father entered the drainage business and the Downs became well respected and widely known in the field for the next 25 years. He became president of the Ontario Farm Drainage Association in 1961.
 In the late '60s, along with his sons

Rick and Ronald, Mr. Downs began doing work for Bell Canada in the cable installation field. He continued in that field until his retirement in 1985.
 Throughout his life, Mr. Downs was quiet, jovial and had a kind nature. Few men of the township were better known or more generally liked than Jimmie Downs.
 He is survived by his wife Vera,

son Rick and wife Jannet, son Ronald, and grandsons Peter and Matthew. His is also survived by his mother Eva of Hornby as well as sisters Dorothy and Norma.
 The funeral, held at the McKersie Funeral Home in Milton June 11, was conducted by Rev. Rod Lewis. It was largely attended.
 The pallbearers were grandsons Peter and Matthew Downs, nephews

Greg Wendover and Kim Mountain of Milton, and family friends Roger Mauro and Bill Prisiak, both of Milton.
 Internment was in Evergreen Cemetery in Milton.
 James A. Downs was a life member of St. Clair Lodge No. 135 A. F. and A. M., and St. Clair Chapter No. 75. G.R.C. A Masonic service was held at the funeral home June 10 under the auspices of St. Clair Lodge.
 Jimmie Downs will be missed always and never forgotten.
