Krantz blames region

"I took exception to that," he said. At that meeting, Mr. Pomeroy told Mayor Krantz that when the landfill decision was handed down - after

considerable input, debate and cost -- "at that time you could have made the decision that you wouldn't have gone to court.

"You would have saved the Region and the (Halton) municipalities millions of dollars. Instead, your municipality, for whatever reason, wanted process." through that

Milton town council and other groups opposed the "better than two-thirds of the landfill at every stage right up to the Supreme Court of Ontario.

Mayor Krantz reiterated that the Region could have saved a lot of money if it had stuck with the original consultant's recommendation in the mid-eighties to put the dump in Burlington.

He added he's "suspicious" of last week's regional council decision to make available a portion of the Milton landfill to the Greater Toronto

"I think a majority of my (regional

council) colleagues see it as a way to recoup money even at the risk of what it could do to Milton."

He elaborated that not enough consideration had been given to social and traffic impacts of trucking in garbage from

> other regions. One likely outcome of this, he conceded, will be higher than anticipated

disposal fees. The site, located on the west side of Highway 25 south of Britannia Road takes up about 300 acres, and involves about a dozen property owners.


