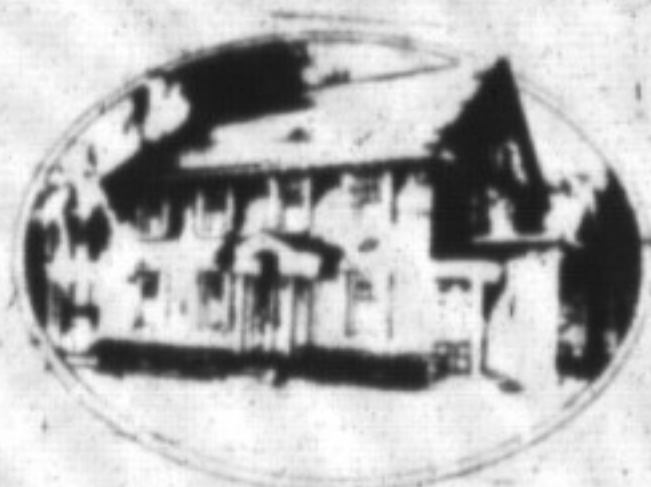

NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton has passed By-law No. 40-90 to designate the following property as being of architectural value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337:

Address of Property: Lot 21, Concession 5, former Township of Nassagaweya now in the Town of Milton, R.R. #2 Rockwood, owned by Dagmar Gorayeb, Jutta Wolfweber (Schubert).

Reason for Proposed Designation: Built in 1890, the Schubert residence at R.R. 2 Rockwood is a typical example of the traditional stone farmhouse in terms of overall design. It is in the design of its windows that the house displays its unusual characteristics.

Incorporating windows of Romanesque, Gothic and Perpendicular design all in a single facade, it is a veritable textbook of rural domestic styles. The paired windows with Romanesque arches and "pendant" keystones, however, appear to be quite unique to the Region.
