Some farm fun for kids

Children can learn more about Ontario's rural heritage by participating in activities at the Ontario Agricultural Museum this summer.

During July and August, three and five-day workshops will be held at the museum.

A program called *Farm Fun* will be offered for kids aged six and seven. The program will focus on familiarizing children with the characteristics and uses of farm animals.

My Collection will be offered for kids aged eight to nine years. In this program, children will develop an understanding of the history of museums by creating their own collections.

Spaces are still available for *Farm Fun* sessions running from July 23 to 27, 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Room is also still available for *My Collection* sessions running from July 31 to August 2, 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Parents can register their children at the Ontario Agricultural Museum. No registrations will be accepted

over the telephone. Situated eight kilometers west of Milton, the museum consists of 32 hectares and more than 30 buildings.

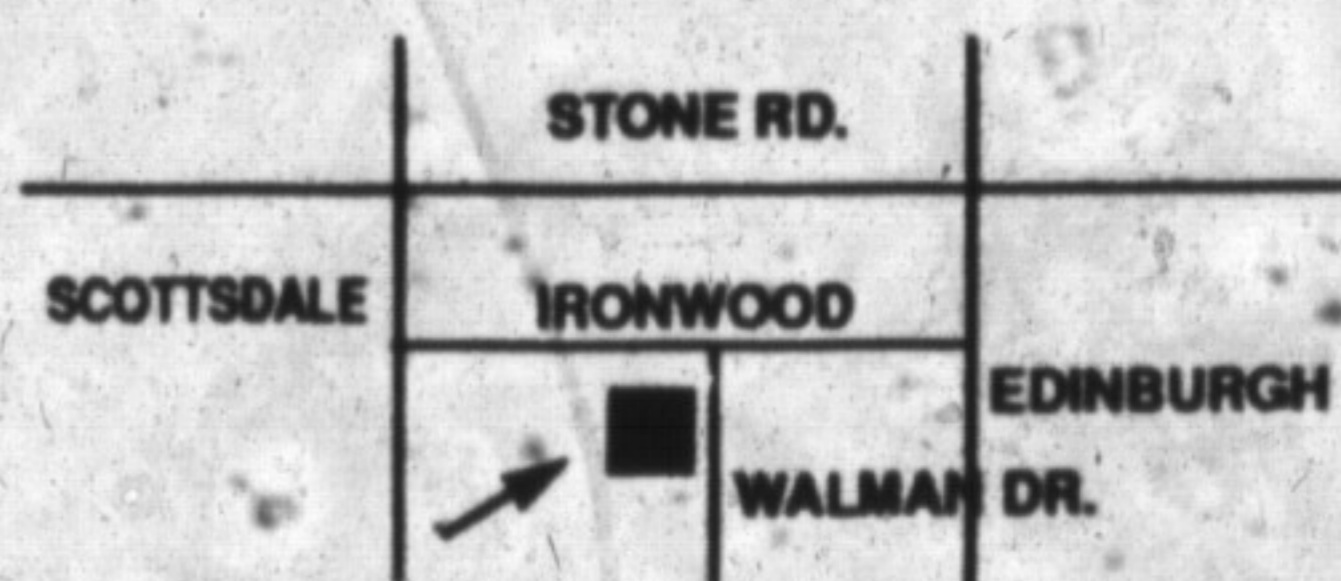
