# Suspicious driver watching children

Police are investigating complaints that a man, seen driving a van with no licence plates, has been peering at children on 9th Line.

An area resident warned police the "suspect appears to be watching the children in the area... (He) shows up during afternoon hours."

The resident said the van could possibly be a Corsica, and described the driver as having short, dark brown hair and a moustache.

### Disappearing act

Two young offenders — one of them considered dangerous — who escaped from the holding cells at Milton courthouse on Thursday were nabbed by police a few hours later.

Police said they were attending Milton courthouse for a bail hearing on other charges.

The 17-year-old Burlington young offender — considered dangerous by police — was picked up about five hours later in Burlington.

The 16-year-old Oakville young offender from Oakville was picked up about eight hours after the escape in Oakville.

Both are charged with escaping lawful custody.

Police were silent on how the escape occurred, saying only that the pair "were last observed in a holding cell in the building with another male young offender who remained at the scene."

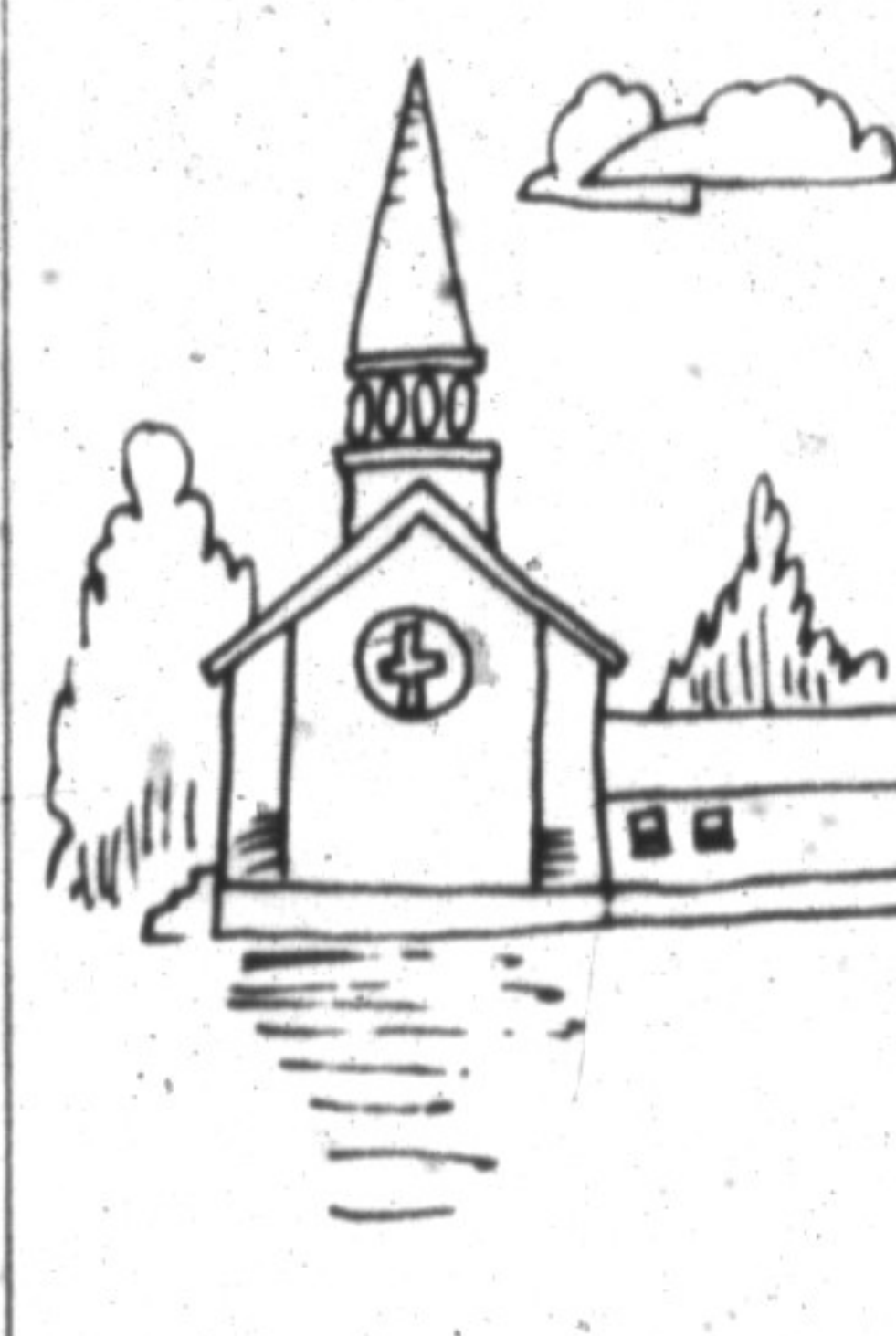
