Can You Vote?

- Are 18 years of age or over
- Are Canadian Citizens
- Have resided in Ontario for the preceding 6 months

- are eligible to vote if their name is on the NEW LIST of VOTERS for the Electoral District in which they reside, or on a CERTIFICATE to VOTE as issued by their Returning Officer.
