Returning to the work force

Information Milton is your community information centre.

This column features questions of general interest that have recently been asked.

Question: I am planning to go back into the work force after 15 years. What is the minimum wage and how many hours am I required to work?

Answer: Most full-time and part-time workers must be paid a minimum of \$5/hr., but there are exceptions. People who serve liquor earn less and students under 18 years of age (working in the summer or less than 28 hours per week during

the school year) earn \$3.90/hr. The normal number of hours per day is eight and 48 per week. If you work in a retail store, for example, you can be required to work 10 hours per day. If you work more than 44 hours per week, you must be paid at least one and a half times your regular wage for each additional hour worked.

By government rules, you will receive seven paid holidays per year. You are also entitled to two weeks holidays after a year of service or four per cent of your salary for the time period worked

Question: I want to register my child for fall activities. Who do I call?

Answer: The Town of Milton's leisure services booklet lists many organizations that offer programs for children and family members. Phone the Town or Information Milton for a copy of the booklet if you have not received it by mail.




