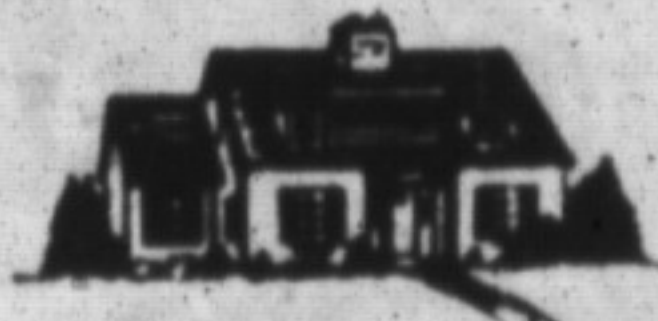
Last year's event raised more than \$15,000 to purchase a fetal monitor for Milton District Hospital.

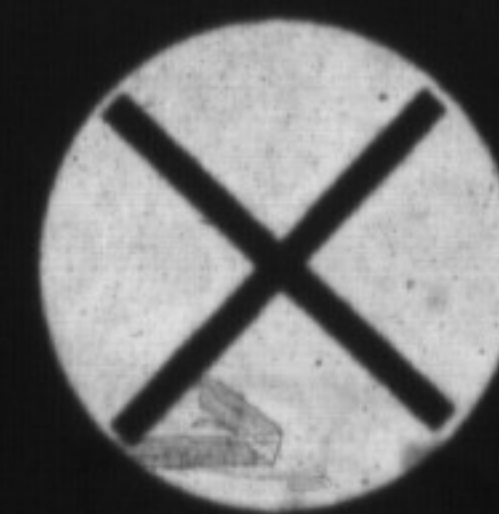
