Gori claims he was misquoted

Giuseppe Gori, the Family Coalition Party candidate vying for the Halton North seat in the provincial election, says he has been misquoted by the Georgetown Independent and therefore an editorial published in the Canadian Champion is inaccurate.

The editorial, "Men of Integrity," was published in the Aug. 29 Canadian Champion and drawn from an account of an all-candidates meeting written by Georgetown Independent reporter Scott Kline.

Mr. Gori said Mr. Kline's portrayal of his behaviour as critical of the moral fibre of other Halton North candidates was inaccurate because there was no personal slight.

At the meeting in question, Liberal incumbent Walt Elliot lashed out at Mr. Gori for what he construed as an attack on his integrity "by innuendo." Mr. Gori said Mr. Elliot took his remarks "personally. I was talking generally."

He also said Mr. Kline misquoted him by attributing the following statement to Mr Gori: "If you want to be represented by a person with integrity and morals you must vote for me." Mr. Gori said the correct quote ended with "vote for one" instead, and contended the difference was substantial.

Mr. Kline and Georgetown Independent editor Hartley Coles said Mr. Kline's quote was accurate. They also indicated the Canadian Champion editorial of Aug. 29 was accurate in both tone and judgement.
