Speaker will boost your business

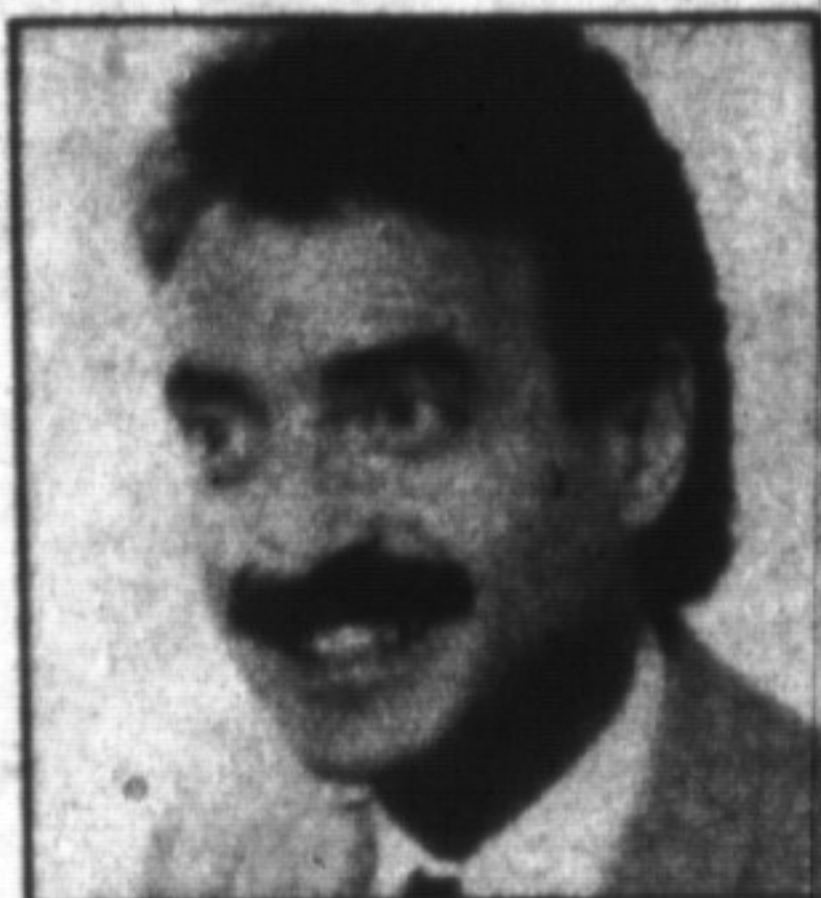
Bill Gibson, known as Canada's top business speaker, will visit Milton next week.
