Merchants' exhibition record at 4-4-1 after tie with Newmarket

The junior B Milton Merchants neared the end of their pre-season campaign with a 4-4 tie against Newmarket on Friday night at Memorial Arena.

Newmarket was a different type of hockey team from that which often inhabits junior B uniforms — they were fast.

Almost to a man the Newmarket '87s seemed faster than the Merchants but Milton appeared better schooled in the fundamentals.

Referee Bob Morley has a "let 'em play" attitude, and true to form he didn't call a penalty until 7:17 remaining of the first. In fact, he didn't blow the whistle until almost eight minutes into the opening frame.

Kitchener Rangers, a major Jr. A team, and has taken delivery of a blueliner in a deal struck with the Rangers. He is Kelly Leroux, a 6'2" 195-pounder. Bince said it is "imperative" Milton dips further into the Ranger talent pool.

The Merchants won their Sunday game against Markham 9-2 at Memorial Arena, though they lost on Saturday in Newmarket 6-5.

To date the Merchants have racked up a 4-4-1 record in pre-season play.

"I've looked at so many faces in the games, sometimes guys who never practised with us, that I think a 500 record is pretty good," Bince said. "With all the hard work we've put in and with all the returnees and our work from last year, we should be in

for a fun and exciting season."

Bince predicts a slow start to the season because he opted to play numerous exhibition games rather than have a heavy schedule of practices.

Last year the Merchants managed a 6-1 record to start the year but Bince credits the long practice hours the team put in.

"We were the most disciplined team in the early going," said Bince. "This year we still have to work on the powerplay, the breakout and penalty killing."

Bince said last year's squad was missing seven of eight pieces needed for a successful team and so far this year he counts three missing links to the chain of a championship.

Newmarket scored on the ensuing power play when Dave Thompson potted one of a number of chances from the slot on goaltender Richard Kim.

According to Milton coach Rick Bince, Kim has made the team, though he and returning goalie Chad Muldoon will not rotate duties. Muldoon will get the bulk of the work.

The Merchants tied it up 18 seconds later when Steve Marino scored from Dana Roberts and Kaul Lavarta. Merchant captain Shawn Healey scored in the second period but Newmarket notched a pair, so the Merchants were required to out-score the 87s 2-1 in the final frame to earn the tie.

John McCloud and Dave McDuffe scored for Milton in the third. Jeff Gosselin, Quang Ly and Rohan Halko scored for Newmarket. Referee Morley called a total of five minor penalties in a very chippy contest, four against Milton.

"They're a young, fast hockey club," said Bince, adding, "we're hurting big time on defence."

The arrangement should help all the clubs by increasing their depth and allowing talented players an option to move up the ladder in the same team system.
