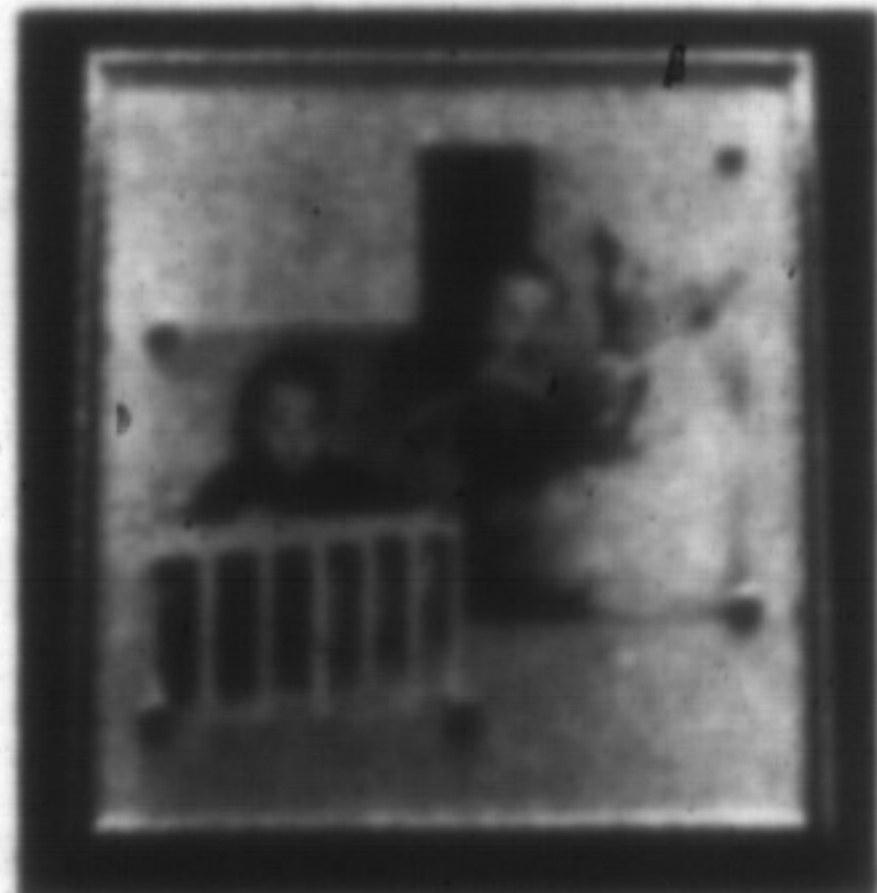

Art auction hopes for healthy donations

The newly-created Halton chapter of the Canadian Mental Health Association is hoping its first fundraising effort will be well received by Halton residents, particularly those in Milton and Halton Hills.

The art auction, to be held at the Royal Botanical Gardens in Burlington on Friday Oct. 12, is the group's primary fundraiser, said association executive director Pearl Wolfe.

Previously the auction was held just for the Burlington chapter, Ms Wolfe said. It has now been adopted as the main fundraising initiative for all Halton. The Halton-wide chapter formed in the summer when the Burlington and Oakville associations amalgamated and expanded throughout the region.

"One of the reasons it's so important is that our fundraising needs for the north are so great," she said.

Elaborating, she said, "we basically took the resources of two branches

(Oakville and Burlington) and are trying to serve an area that is one-third larger with no additional resources.

"You can call it a plea for help. We would really appreciate support."

The ticket price for the event is \$15, which includes wine and cheese and a chance at an art door prize. The preview is at 6:30 p.m. and the auction begins at 8 p.m. Last year, it raised \$10,000 for the Burlington chapter.

"Even if you don't make a purchase, you will have had an entertaining evening," she said.

Meanwhile, she said the amalgamation has gone smoothly.

"We're pretty proud that we've been able to get things started even with our limited resources," she said.
