# Replacing and adding new windows isn't a pain

Unlike any other part of a home, windows serve a unique purpose: they are a major source of natural light and fresh air, and they provide us with a view of the outdoors. Several types of windows can be found in both old and new homes, including fixed windows, (with no moving parts), horizon-

and double-hung sash windows. If you're thinking of replacing your windows to improve energy efficiency, or adding windows to give your home a new look, there are several things you should keep in mind.

First of all, consider the type of windows you want to install and what your budget limitations are.

If you intend to replace your present windows with larger ones, you should choose something that will blend in well with the existing windows and line up with either the tops or bottoms of the other windows. Consider how this will affect your home's appearance — both inside and out.

If you're going to be creating new window space, you should carefully consider the style, size and location and make sure the new additions complement the style of your house.

Also consider the type of lighting you want these windows to supply and the effect you want to create. Windows help set the mood of a room, so if you want to achieve a distinctive look, make sure you choose the appropriate windows. And if you have a spectacular view you want to frame, make sure the window you choose will showcase. it to your satisfaction.

Ventilation is another important factor to consider when choosing windows. Windows that are placed in a low position in a wall can help direct the incoming air flow downward. When open, windows that are placed opposite each other can create a continuous airflow.

You should also consider how the location

of the new windows will affect the amount of heat your house will gain. For instance, windows that face north tend to be net energy losers, while those that face south (other than those that are single glazed) tend to be net gainers.

Many types of windows are available on tal sliding windows, casement windows, the market today. Some have wooden frames that are clad in vinyl or metal; others are made of tough plastic or fibreglas. These types of windows generally require very little maintenance. Frames and sashes made

from wood and plastic tend to have the best insulation value.

When choosing new windows, you'll undoubtedly want double or triple- glazed thermal units. The thickness of airspace between each layer of glazing determines the insulating value of the unit and maximizes energy efficiency. Consider window units with a wider amount of spacing between the panes - three-quarters of an inch is about the maximum.

Low emissivity glass can also provide bet-

ter energy efficiency. In cold climates, this type of glass has a thin metallic coating on the outer surface of the inner pane. (In hot climates the reverse is true.) This coating is designed to reduce heat loss.

#### Compare Ratings

When shopping for windows, check the air leakage rate; obviously, a low rate will indicate the unit is very energy efficient. Also check for resistance to water leakage and wind and be sure to examine and compare the insulating value, price, durability, and appearance.


