Unlike the Toronto Maple Leafs, the Milton Devils view coaching as a key asset in an upcoming charity match against the internationally famous Flying Fathers at Memorial Arena on Tuesday, Nov. 3.

That's because the Devils — as the local conglomeration of skaters have tabbed themselves — have talked former star defenceman of the Chicago Black Hawks, Pierre Pilote, into pacing behind the bench as assistant coach.

Assisting Mr. Pilote behind the bench will be Jim Gallant, a teacher at Bishop Reding Secondary School and coach of the school's senior girls championship field hockey team. The Devils are also hoping a few calls may go their way with former NHL referee Bruce Hood wearing the stripes, assisted by linesman Murray McConnell.

Opening faceoff is at 8 p.m. and all ticket holders will be invited to a post game social in the upper level of the arena to meet the Flying Fathers.

The Milton Devils will consist of Bishop Reding teachers, various Milton celebrities as well as a special import — Sue Scherer, former captain of Team Canada's ladies hockey team and now a spokesperson for the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association.

Tickets are still available but must be purchased in advance of the game as no tickets will be sold at the door. Tickets — available at Fitness Technique, Jack Frasers, Man's World, West End Auto and Pro-Skate Exchange, — are \$6 for adults and \$4 for children, students and seniors.
