

# Alliston Star and Lukes Chantal take two-year-olds finals

Six finals of the Canadian Breeder's Championships went postward at Mohawk Raceway in Campbellville last weekend. Four events for two-year-olds took the spotlight Saturday while the sophomores were featured Sunday night.

Alliston Star paced a wire-to-wire 1:59.4 effort to win the \$92,181 two-year-old pacing fillies race for driver-trainer Jim Whelan. Alliston Star clocked fractions of 28.6 seconds, 59.9 and 1:30 before breaking the beam half a length ahead of Classy Sis. Island Fund was third.

The win was number 11 in 15 starts on the year for the daughter of Willow Wiper, who was bred by owner Clarence Varcoe of Alliston. With the win her purse earnings surpass \$125,000.

"She's a nice all-round filly," said Whelan. "She's good mannered and she's a lot easier racing on the front." The horse has two Sires Stakes races and the Sire Stakes Championship left on her calendar.

Omahoiyanna benefitted from a pocket trip and came out in the stretch drive to nip pacesetter Island Fund by a neck for a 201.2 victory in the \$19,753 elimination earlier.

Lil Orphan Ellie closed, to be second in a dead heat with Island Fund. Trainer-driver Bob Walker was at the helm of the chestnut daughter of Armbrø Omaha, who posted her third win in 16 starts and increased her bank account to \$32,915 for owners-breeders Adelle and Andy Siegrist of Allenford.

Alliston Star, a Willow Wiper filly, had everything her own way in the second elimination. She paced a wire-to-wire 1:59.6 effort for trainer-driver Jim Whelan for her 10th win in 14 season starts and to add to her bankroll, bringing it to \$79,484 for owner-breeder Clarence Varcoe of Alliston. Daisy Harbour was second and Classic Sis was third.

The field for the \$58,889 Canadian Breeder's Final for two-year-old trotting fillies was Luke's Chantal, Island Ferry, Lady Orbitex, Stormont Go Lucky, N.V. Gemma, Moorelands Avis, Oaklea Annie, Boscobess and Shipp's Doll.

Luke's Chantal took command from the start of the race and al-

though he briefly surrendered it at the three quarter pole he was the best at the wire, crossing in 2:03.8.

Shipp's Doll was second a length back and Island Ferry was third. The win was the Dream of Glory filly's sixth in nine starts and increased her purse account to \$98,147 for owner-breeder Luke Emard of Cornwall.

Emard credits Lukes Chantal's success to Tom Strauss' Emard, who is in the lumber as well as the breeding business, sells 10 foals a year but last year decided to keep Luke's Chantal.

"She started late but she's well mannered and has always showed good (sic). She's a filly who would catch your eye if never planned on selling her."

Trainer John Bax enjoyed one of his rare appearances at Mohawk Raceway, by taking to the winner's circle following an elimination race in the same category the previous Sunday.

His filly Island Ferry cruised to a two-length, 2:02.2 lifetime best in winning the \$12,618 elimination.

Bax, who owns Parkhill Stud Farm in Peterborough, purchased the chestnut daughter of Balanced Image along with James Boughton and Liberty North for \$19,000 at the Select Sale as a yearling in 1989.

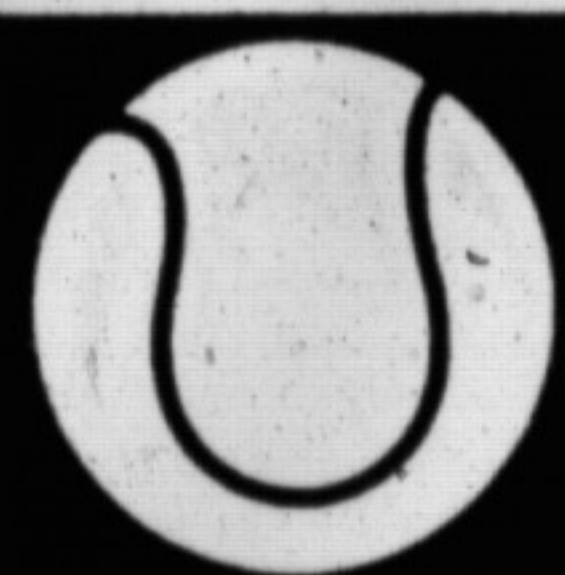
"She's hot at the gate," said Bax. "She likes to leave and she's perfectly gaited. I thought we had a shot at being in the first three but I didn't think we'd win."

Island Ferry led from start to finish and staved off a late challenge in the stretch from Shipp's Doll and Tim Twaddle. Stormont Go Lucky was third.

The win was her fifth in 13 starts and gave her \$73,826 in season's earnings.

In the second \$12,618 elimination Luke's Chantal trotted a wire-to-wire 2:03.3 victory for trainer-driver Tom Strauss. Owned by breeder Luke Emard of Cornwall, it was the Dream of Glory offspring's fifth win in eight starts and boosted her bank account to \$68,072 on the year.
