The rationale, explained Halton Region public works supervisor Bruce Kitchen, is that instead of pouring the discharge into Sixteen Mile Creek, where it simply tumbles down to Lake Ontario, it's put to better use, such as the watering of parks and golf courses.

'This concept is used extensively in the southern United States for recreation and irrigation purposes," said Mr. Kitchen in a recent staff.

Although we do not have the same type of climate and the severe water restrictions they have, I believe that consideration should be given to Milton's request."


