

Oakville Blades the real competition for Milton

from BINCE on page 15 completed a carbon copy of the goal, *deja vu* for Chad Muldoon. Two minutes later Sandy Sajko picked up a rebound at the point and hammered one past the Milton keeper. In the second frame Milton again scored at the mid-point, with Trevor

an injury. "We should have been blown out," Bince said. "With Cuff in the net, then they win." Bince is convinced that the Merchants are deep enough in talent that they should have won despite missing Clarke and Daw, the two

brightest lights of the early season. The Merchants got all five of their goals from fourth line players. Now that he's been around the league a few times Bince is convinced that his team is the one to beat and that their toughest competition is Oakville. In three games against the Blades Milton's record is one win and two ties.

"Brampton's a joke," Bince said of the Capitals. "There's not a problem with them unless we have to put on boxing gloves."

Oakville is a different story. "Ken Moodie's like me," Bince said. "Even if you don't give me the cream, I can still make a good cup of coffee."

"I knew we'd be strong, that we'd have a run for the roses but to really put it all together we need a few new faces. We need a strong centre who can win faceoffs in the tough spots and we're weak on the left side. It wouldn't hurt to get a little muscle either, just so we won't be vulnerable."

"I've had enough of (Brampton coach) Frank Carnevale," Bince said. "I can't stand him. He's an immature coach."

Bince alleged that Carnevale stole a player, Chris Frazer, whose release from the Windsor Spitfires Junior A team, Bince contended, was purchased by Milton. "Carnevale stole him with some trip to Europe he promised him. He thinks it's a joke."

Herstad said that Streetsville and Brampton can't be counted out with less than half the schedule completed.

The Merchants next play at home Friday night when they host Streetsville at 8 p.m. at Memorial Arena.
