Prison escapee arrested at father's Milton home

A 26-year-old Milton man is back in custody after escaping from a Kingston prison last week.

Halton Regional Police said Joseph Finn escaped from Warkworth Medium Security Prison at about 7:15 p.m., November 20, by scaling a fence.

Two days later, Halton Regional Police converged at his father's Ontario Street home after receiving information that he possibly was there.

At about 6:10 p.m., police said, he suddenly ran out of the back door of

the apartment building and was arrested, without incident, after a short foot race.

He was held in custody in Georgetown, pending the arrival of escort officers from Kingston. Halton Regional Police laid no charges.

In January, Mr. Finn was sentenced to three years in prison for several criminal offences, including assault, theft, and attempted break and enter.

Impaired driving charges

A 19-year-old Hagersville teenager faces impaired driving charges after police received a call from a citizen concerned about a 1987 Pontiac Grand Prix being driven erratically in a Main Street East parking lot.

When police arrived on the scene about 1:40 a.m. early Thursday morning, the citizen pointed out the suspect, who at this point was not in the vehicle. Police said he refused to take a breathalyzer test.

A minor vehicle accident early Thursday evening at E.C. Duffy resulted in impaired driving charges being laid against a 63-year-old Milton man.

Police said breathalyzer tests indicated a blood alcohol content of more than double the legal limit.

Mischief charges

A 23-year-old Milton male is charged with mischief following an incident during an office party at Mohawk Raceway shortly after midnight last Wednesday.

Police said the suspect, following an argument with a female friend, flipped over a table and chairs.

Efforts to calm him were apparently unsuccessful and he later smashed his fist through several windows, then "sat down and cried."

He was taken to Milton District Hospital for several stitches.

Drug transactions often take place in public places such as plazas, malls, parking lots and street corners and are often made without much attempt to hide them from passers-by.

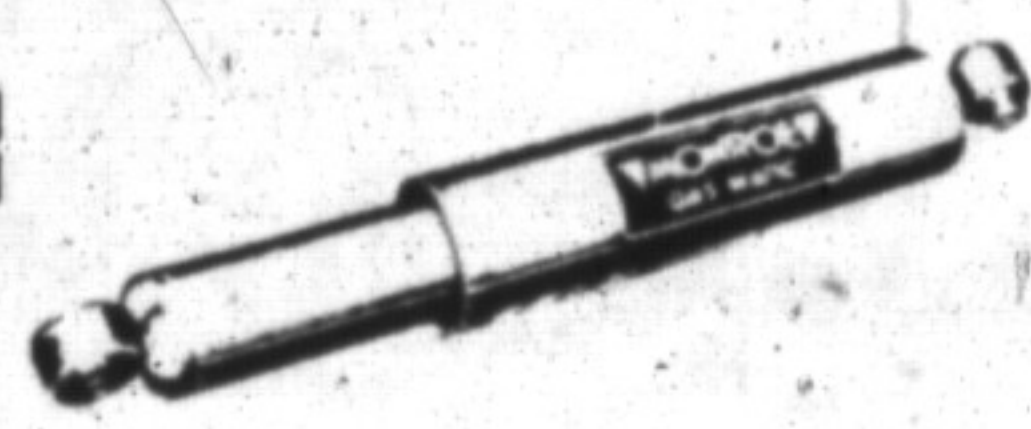
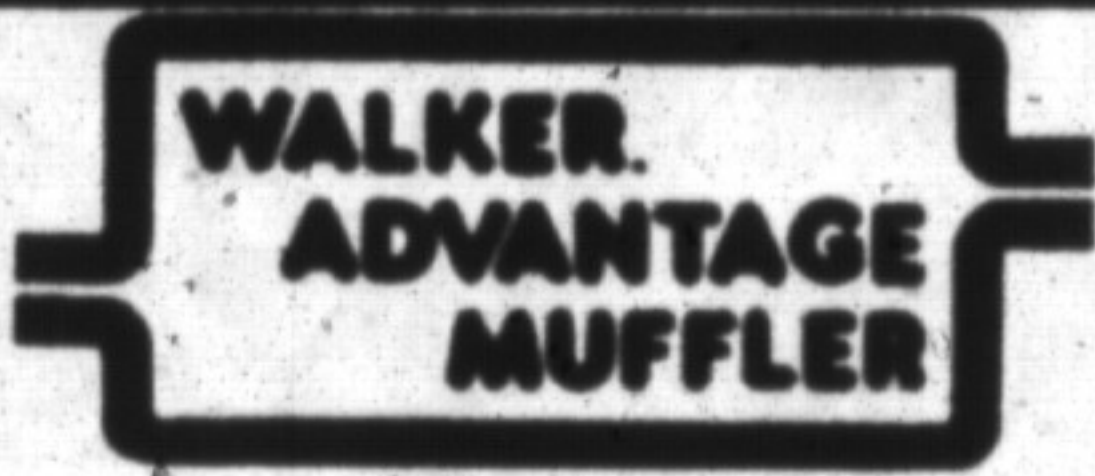
Other drug dealers visit local schools to peddle their products to students. More frequently, drug pushers use their own homes, hoping to avoid the attention of patrolling police officers.
