"I've got nothing to do with the snack bar, but that doesn't mean I don't want it."

Stover said Grant has never threatened to move the Merchants over the concession issue.

## Springer fund-raising successful in special drive

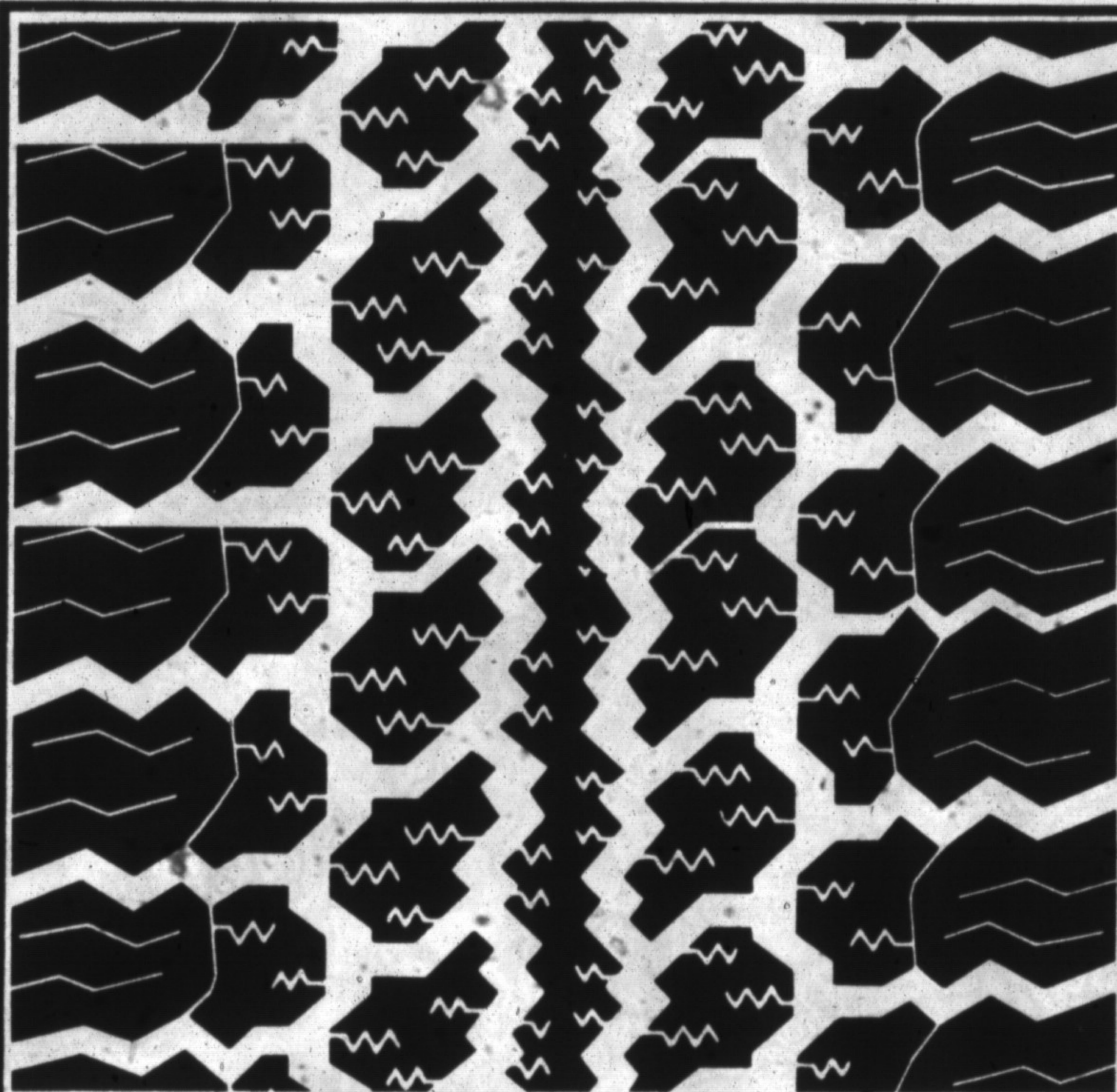
The Milton Springers Gymnastic Club just completed a major fund-raising effort to augment the funds they raise through bingo.

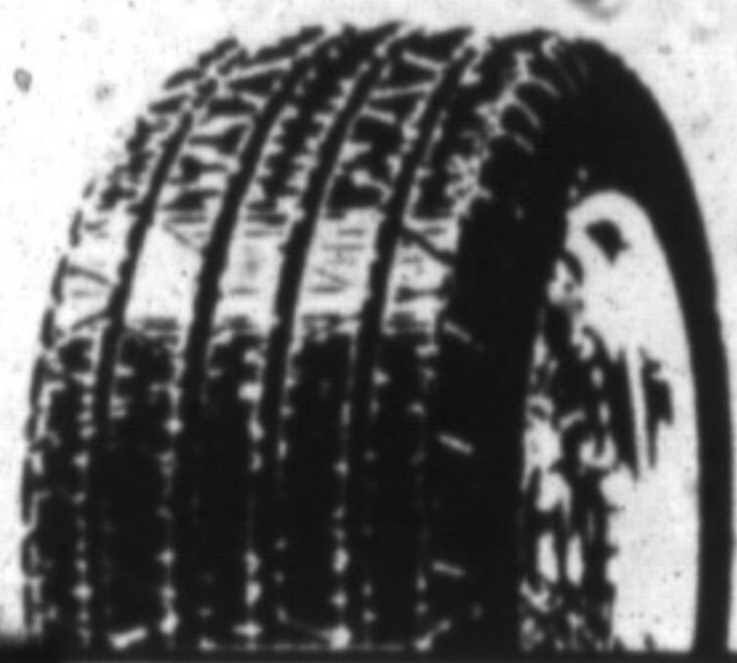
