Christmas trees a popular theme in this season's crop of books

At the beginning of December each year, I pull our family's box of Christmas books out of the closet and we reacquaint ourselves with well-loved friends. This December, we are adding eight new stories to our Christmas library. These moving tales transport us across Canada, to different cultures and to different times.

The Christmas tree features in four of the books. In *The Little Crooked Christmas Tree* by Michael Cutting (Scholastic, \$12.95), a tree matures on a Christmas tree farm only to be rejected by visiting families because it has not grown tall and straight. The tree despairs of ever delighting families at Christmas. Artist Ron Broda's gorgeous paper sculptures enhance

the text. A cassette (\$10.95) is also available with Christopher Plummer as narrator. (The book and cassette gift package costs \$24.95)

The tree in Allan Crow's *The Crying Christmas Tree* (illustrated by David Beyer, Pemmican, Winnipeg, \$10.95) also wants to celebrate Christmas before returning to the soil. On an Indian reserve in Whitefish Bay,

an old woman drags home a tree which her grandchildren discard because it is too scrawny. Their insensitivity hurts her greatly, but fortunately, they realize their mistake before it is too late.

Timmy, in Elsie Hadden Mole's *A Christmas Tree for Puddin' Stone Hill* (illustrated by Sylvia Hahn, Penubra Press, \$6.95), feels grown up when his mother allows him to go in search of a Christmas tree. Black Cat helps Timmy discover the perfect tree.

You might think that *Baseball Bats for Christmas* (Annick, \$5.95 paperback, \$14.95 hardcover) has nothing to do with trees, but in 1955 at Repulse Bay, six pine trees are delivered by airplane to the settlement, just before Christmas. Unfamiliar with "standing-ups", the Inuit boys wonder what purpose they serve. Finally, a boy chops off the branches from one of the trees and transforms it into a baseball bat. Michael Arvaarluk Kusugak, who co-authored *A Promise is a Promise* with Robert Munsch, wrote the story. Illustrator Viadyana Kryorka travelled to northern Canada to study the people and their landscape.

Ethel Williamson's *The Little Seamstress* (illustrated by Pat Robertson, Moonstone Press, Goderich, \$4.95), takes us back to the 19th century. Astra, a young orphan, travels to a mining town in northern Canada to live with her grandmother who teaches her how to sew. One day, a strange, little man arrives with an order to make a red velvet suit with white fur trim for his master. You can guess who that jolly, old fellow turns out to be.

It is 1800 in the backwoods of Upper Canada. Lucy and Dan are preparing a generous gift for their parents who cannot afford to celebrate Christmas. Jane Lunn's text and Lindsay Grater's watercolours have created a heartwarming story in *One Hundred Shining Candles* (Lester & Orpen Dennys, \$15.95).

Venture into Acadian history with *The Magic Rug of Grand Pre* by Rejean Aucoin and Jean-Claude Tremblay (illustrated by Hermenegilde Chiasson, Nimbus, Halifax, \$10.95). On Christmas Eve, Johnny a Minou, the magic mailman, flies two children to the four corners of Cape Breton Island in search of 12 strands of wool needed to complete a hooked rug begun in 1755, just before the English deported the Acadians.

During his stay with the Hurons, the Jesuit missionary Father Jean de Brebeuf, composed a beautiful carol which we continue to sing today. Illustrator Frances Tyrell strives for accuracy as well as beauty in *The Huron Carol* (Lester & Orpen Dennys, \$15.95). Her constellations that border the pages, for example, would have appeared in a December sky in 1648 and the palisades and longhouses resemble those of 17th century Fort Ste. Marie.
