**Surprise filled muffins make tasty gifts**

Practice a little magic this holiday season. Hide a delicious surprise of orange-flavoured cheese in carrot muffins.

These easy-to-make muffins will show friends you care not only about pleasing their tastebuds but also their health. Carrots and bran cereal add nutrition sense to these sweet holiday treats.

**Carrot Cream Cheese Bran Muffins**

- 1 (125 g pkg) cream cheese softened;
- 1 tbsp grated orange rind;
- 1 tbsp orange juice;
- 1 egg;
- 1 1/4 cups milk;
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil;
- 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar;
- 1 1/2 cup Nabisco 100% Bran Cereal;
- 1 cup shredded carrots;

- 1/2 cup raisins;
- 1 1/2 cups whole wheat flour;
- 1 tbsp. baking powder;
- 1 tsp. ground cinnamon;
- 1/2 tsp. salt;

**Directions:** Grease 12 large muffin tins or line with paper baking cups. Beat cream cheese, granulated sugar, orange rind and juice until smooth; set aside. Beat egg lightly with fork.

Stir in milk, vegetable oil and brown sugar. Add cereal, carrots and raisins. In large bowl, combine remaining ingredients. Stir cereal mixture into dry ingredients mixing just until moistened. Spoon half of batter into muffin cups; spoon 1 tbsp cheese mixture over each; top with remaining batter.

Bake at 400F for 20 to 25 minutes or until golden brown. Cool on rack. Store in airtight container. Makes 12 muffins.
