## Drury students busy painting the town

E.C. Drury High School students were out painting the town — literally — for Christmas last week. About 15 painting and decorating students painted seasonal pictures on the windows and doors of Milton businesses — Tim Horton's and Swiss Chalet.

"This is a perfect application for the skills the students have been developing in the last three months," says Gunter Schade, master tradesman and E.C. Drury teacher.

"The added incentive is that businesses pay the students who split the money among themselves. Immediately, they understand that they have a way of making a living."

Mr. Schade's classes have been painting candles, wreaths and Santa's face on store windows in town for the last few years.

## Teacher is year-round Santa

E.C. Drury High School teacher Gunter Schade has collected and personally delivered almost 2,000 hard covered books to the children of Parson's Pond, a small fishing village in western Newfoundland.

"When I heard that the library was going to ship used books to South America, I spoke up and asked that they be sent to children here in Canada who needed them just as much," said Mr. Schade.

He first experienced Parson's Pond when he drove through it on his way to Labrador in 1983. The tiny village brought back strong memories of his own childhood in northern Europe.

"This past summer, I had great fun teaching the local children how to paint signs for their homes and their father's boats.

If you have any hard cover books that you no longer need, please drop them off at E.C. Drury High School so Mr. Schade can truck them to Parson's Pond in the summer.

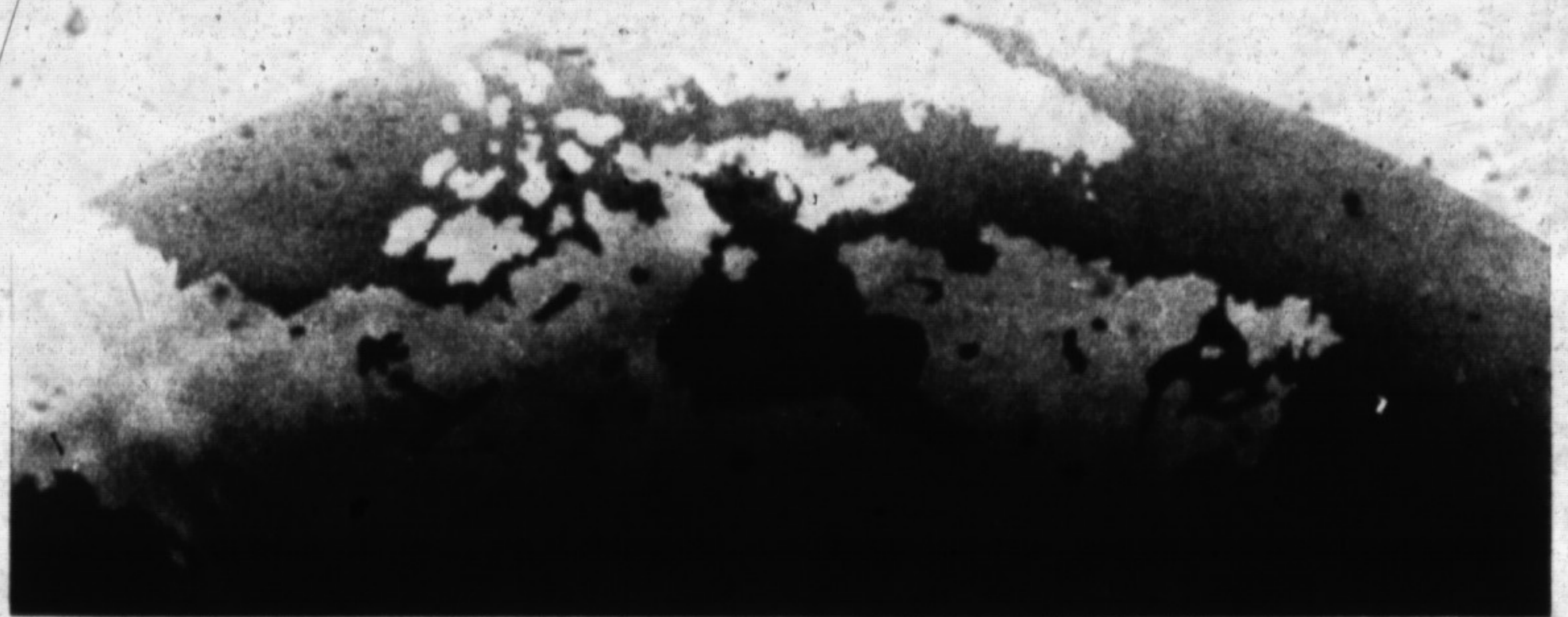

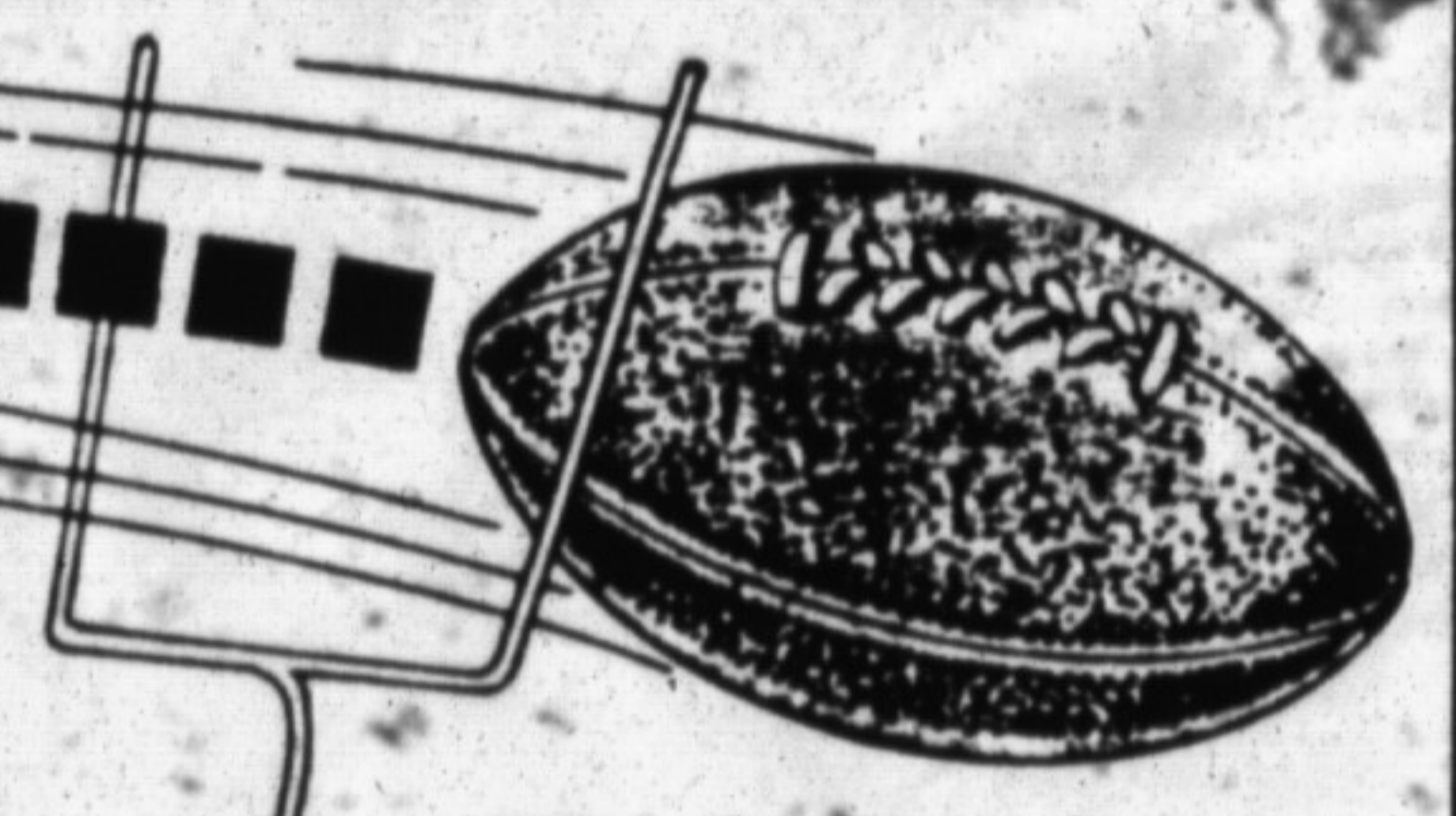
