Maybe you've resolved not to make New Year's resolutions this year, so you won't feel guilty about breaking them.

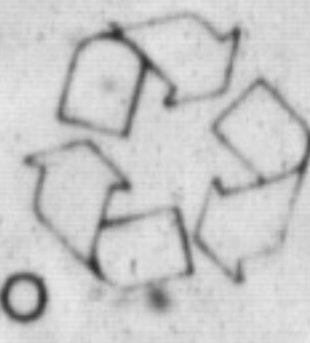
