**Side-swiper sought after Saturday smash-up**

A car, halted at a stop sign at Mc-Niven Road and Steeles Avenue early Saturday morning, was side-swiped by another car which then fled the scene.

Police say a two-door, burgundy or red Chevrolet Beretta broad-sided a 1991 Ford Probe at 1:17 a.m. and was last seen driving south on McNiven Road.

The driver is described as male, white, between 16 and 18 years of age, with brown, mushroom-cut hair, and wearing a football jacket.
