 goods into categories while keeping records of all items coming in and going out. They also stock the shelves at the Main Street Salvation Army location.

The fact that some people can't afford to buy food bothers Mr. Mistruzzi, 65. "If people need food for Christmas Day, what do they eat the day after?" he wondered.

The couple worked steadily for three weeks to keep the food bank operating during the holiday season. "We're tired at the end of the day but it's a good feeling," said Mrs. Mistruzzi, 63.

She said the pair was thrilled with

the support the food bank received this season. "We were really worried before Christmas that we weren't going to have enough (food), but we were amazed by the generosity of the Milton people."

"We got 5,000 pounds more than we did last Christmas," added Mr. Mistruzzi.

The facility exists through a co-operative effort. Among several churches, companies and other organizations, the Milton Fire Department as well as the Town of Milton came through with large contributions of food and personal care items in December last year, said Mrs. Zelinsky.
