To do this, take your total monthly gross income and multiply it times 30 per cent. The resulting figure will give you the amount available for mortgage payments and property taxes.

You should also calculate your total debt service (TDS) ratio. Take your total monthly gross income and multiply it by 40 per cent. The resulting figure will give you the amount available for mortgage payments, property taxes and fixed monthly payments, such as loans and credit cards.

These ratios are used by lending institutions to qualify borrowers for mortgages. The most common type of mortgage is "conventional," where lenders will loan up to 75 per cent of the appraised value (estimated market value) of the property or purchase price - whichever is lower.
