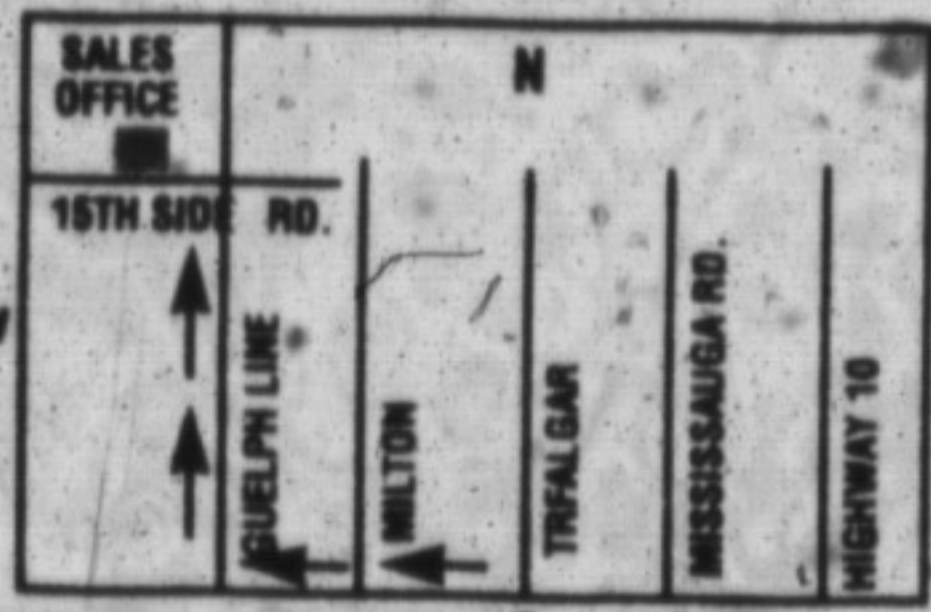

"My sense of this council is that there is a real willingness and determination to do at least that."

Since inflation is so low at present, holding the line at 1991 levels won't entail as much sacrifice as it might have if prices and wage demands had risen quickly in a more heated economy," he added. "We're not going to cut back a lot of services."

Asked if it meant contemplating freezing salaries for councillors and municipal department heads, Mr. Challinor replied, "sure it does."

The councillor was critical of the NDP provincial government for running up the deficit to more than \$9 billion last year. "They should not have spent the money they spent in 1991. Everybody knew there was a recession. They should have looked at layoffs in the public sector and they should have frozen (public sector) salaries then."

While Mr. Challinor has already by and large chosen a course of action, senior staff members at Town Hall

were still puzzling through exactly what the provincial announcement means.

Milton treasurer Jim McQueen said documents he's seen only refer to the one per cent increase applying to unconditional grants given municipalities. Milton gets about \$500,000 in such funding from Ontario a year.

But he wants to know how much the Town can expect in conditional grants, a more important source of municipal revenue at about \$2.5 million a year. The conditional grants are for such things as road repair and reconstruction, and financing municipal transit. No mention was made of them, he pointed out.

Acting town administrator Bill Roberts said "you can pretty well presume we'll be getting the same thing (one per cent)," across the board from Queen's Park.

"Who knows?" Mr. McQueen said. From the rumours he's heard, municipalities will have to wait until next month to find out for sure, the treasurer said.



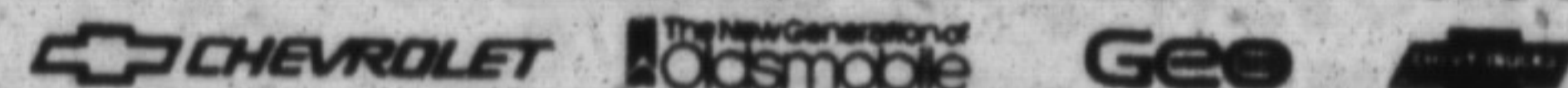

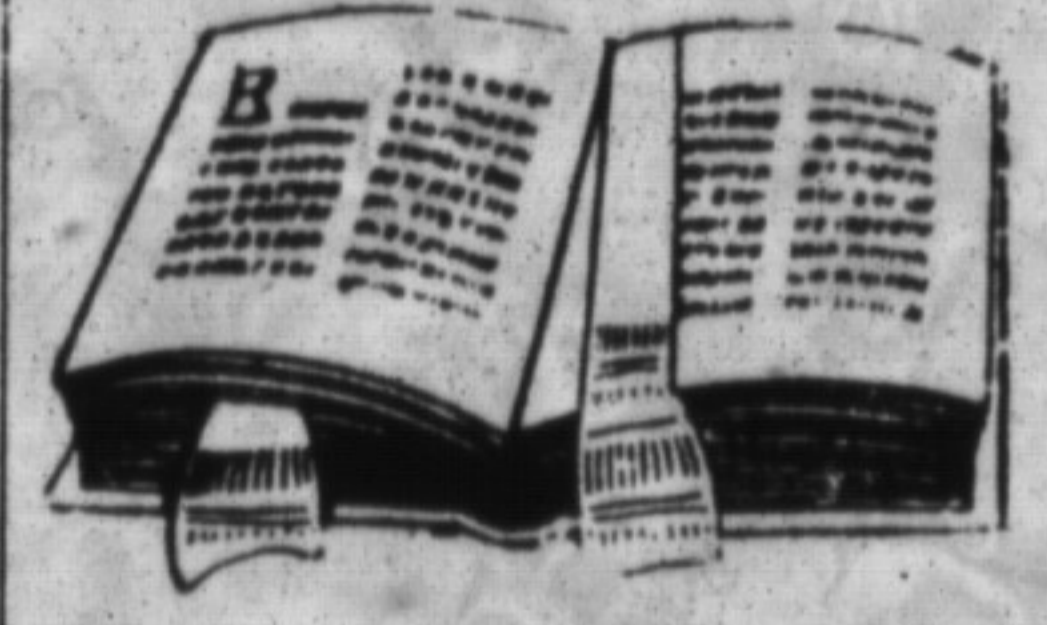
