
Good etiquette makes skiing safe

How many times have you been moving along in the lift line and the people behind you are all over your ski equipment? There is no reason to be this close and it is dangerous.

If you are skiing by yourself try to double with someone when using a t-bar or chairlift. The lift line will move more quickly and you might just meet a new friend as a result.



When riding a chair don't try to bang the snow off your skis as you are going up. This can result in a ski falling among skiers below the lift.

If you see a skier on the hill who has fallen, ski to them to see if they need help. Stop and pick up their skis or poles that might be uphill from them. The assistance will be appreciated and possibley reciprocated.

If you stop and talk to people on the hill please make sure that you go over to the side of the hill. There is nothing more annoying than people standing in the middle of a run just talking or resting. Please make sure that skiers at the top of the hill can see you. Never, never stop anywhere where you can't be seen.
