

Exercise not watered down

Sweat and exercise generally go hand-in-hand, unless a swimming pool is entered into the equation.

When an exercise routine moves from the gym to the pool it becomes aquacise — a cool, less strenuous way to get fit. Aquacise came to town a week ago when classes began at the new Milton Leisure Centre.

The nine-week program has attracted a variety of participants from grandmothers to pregnant women, many of whom are "aquacising" for the first time.

"You're all here for different reasons," said instructor Laurie Williams during an introductory talk at the start of the Friday session.

She says some get involved on a doctor's recommendation, others want to socialize or enjoy a time for themselves while some are using exercise to supplement a weight loss program.

Pat Robinson joined the program for the exercise and to meet people. She first experienced the aquatic program when she joined a friend at a class in Markham.

When Kim Gwillam says she joined the class because a friend talked her into it, she's referring to Pat. The tour she took of the new centre also helped convince her to get involved. 'It's wonderful. It's about time we had something like this and I'll definitely use phase two as well," Kim said.

"I love the water but I never learned to swim. With seven kids I never had the time," says Grace VanderVliet.

Her daughter, Marilyn Trento convinced her to join the program. After their first session the pair admitted they were happy they signed up.

"You don't realize how much work you're doing," said Kim Allan as she relaxed in the whirlpool after the one-hour session.

A swimmer all of her life, Kim said she's impressed with the new facility and can't wait for the second phase to get underway.

The women had spent their first lesson learning some of the basic elements of the program. Classes start by warming up muscles with some brisk walking and jogging back and forth in the pool. A session of stretches is followed by aerobic exercises that include arm and leg work.

The instructor explained the reasoning behind the warm-up and stretching segments and went on to describe the benefits of the toning exercises that follow the aerobics. Floats are used during the final segment and there's background music throughout the class to help par-

There are a few spaces left for participants in the aquacise program. Classes geared to seniors run from 9:30-10:15 a.m. Monday, however anyone can join; other sessions are held: 11 a.m. to noon Monday; 9:30 to 10:15 a.m. Wednesday; and Friday, 11 a.m. to noon. Cost is \$40 for one class a week for nine weeks. Those who join after the program has begun will

receive discounts based on the number of classes missed. To register or to find out more about leisure centre programs call 878-SWIM (7946).
