Book traces 150-year history of St. John's

A century and five decades have passed since an Anglican congregation was established in the rural Township of Nassagaweya. And today's members would like to tell you all about it."

Through a series of events and projects, the congregation of St. John's Anglican Church is celebrating its 150th birthday.

One of the projects has been completed — the publication of a 90-page book called Footprints, which traces the 150 years of congregational life in the parish. 





Pioneer Leisure Swims for those aged 55 and over are held every Monday and Wednesday from 1:30 to 2:30 p.m. The program includes use of both pools, sauna and whirlpool.

Parent and Pre-schooler Leisure Swims are for parents and their preschoolers, 5 years of age and under,

Adult Swims for those 18 years of age and over have use of both pools, sauna and whirlpool Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9:30 to 10:30 p.m. and Wednesdays from 9 to 10:30 p.m. The water slide is open Wednesdays.

Noon Hour Swims can be enjoyed by people aged 13 and over Monday to Friday from 12 noon to 1:30 p.m. Both pools, sauna and whirlpool are included.

Krazy Kids Swims are the thing to do Friday and Saturday evenings. Meet your friends from 8:30 to 10 p.m. Fridays and 7 to 8:30 p.m. Saturdays for fun and excitement. Adults welcome, too. Use of all facilities for certain age groups.
