

Royals setting winning tradition, says Arsenault

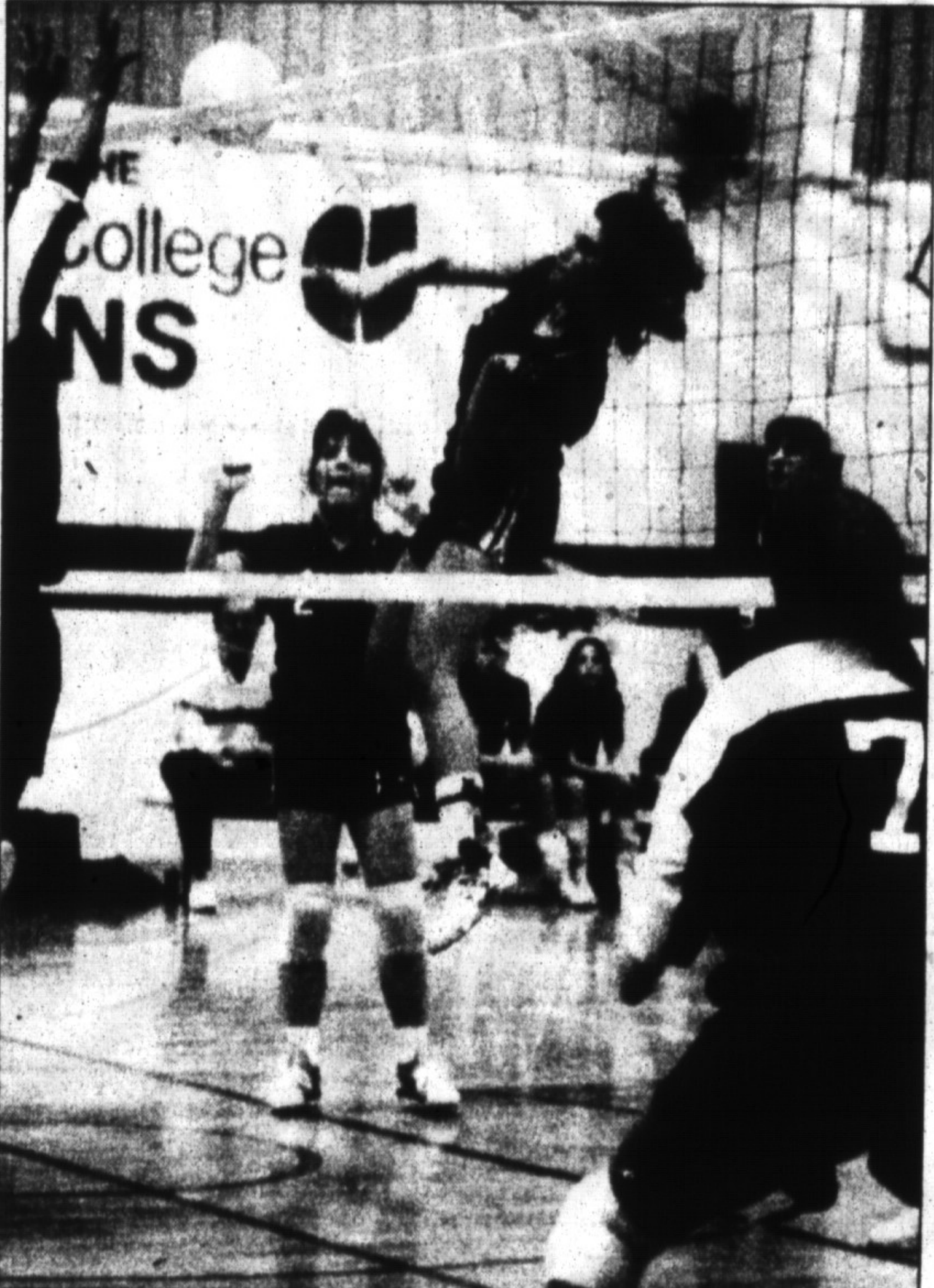
