

## Editor joins Press Council

Champion editor Jane Muller has been elected to the Ontario Press Council along with another newspaper editor and two columnists.

The four professional members replace journalists who left the council at the end of 1991. Ms Muller joins columnists Gillian Sadinsky of the *Kingston Whig-Standard*; Tom Nunn of the *Kitchener-Waterloo Record*; and Earle B. Gill, ex-

ecutive editor of the *Toronto Globe and Mail*.

The 21-member council deals primarily with complaints from the public against Ontario newspapers. It comprises 10 public members, 10 journalists and a public chairman.

Ms Muller started with *The Champion* in 1980 as a reporter and section editor and was promoted to editor in 1986.

## Recycling in the bag

The bags serve as a cover for customers' cleaned clothes and as a laundry bag for items being dropped off at the cleaners. The cost of the bag will be refunded with dry cleaning coupons.

The cleaners launched the recycling program last week. At that time it was also announced that the businesses were already filtering and recycling their dry cleaning solutions and using hangers made from recycled scrap metal.
