It's maple syrup time again at conservation areas

The sap is flowing at two Halton Region Conservation areas. There is a hint of spring in the air and local woodlots are coming to life after a long winter's rest.

The Maple Syrup Time program at Mountsberg Conservation Area and the Sweet Water Season at Crawford Lake Indian Village operate weekends and holidays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. until April 12 and daily during the winter break from March 16-20.

Mountsberg Conservation Area has a sugar bush with a complete

range of pioneer and modern syrup making demonstrations. Horse drawn wagons take thousands of annual visitors to the sugar bush that includes a sugar house with a wood fueled evaporator and a candy house where maple sugar is made. As long as snow is available, the Mountsberg program includes the age old tradition of making taffy by pouring hot syrup over snow.

The Crawford Lake program takes place in the pre-historic Indian Village where the Sweet Water Season

celebration was an important time during the Indian calendar. Visitors learn how native people discovered 'sweet water' and turned it into maple sugar.

Indian village tours as well as some excellent hiking opportunities are available during the program. On Sunday, March 15, there is a special event at Crawford Lake called 'Sweet Water Day'. This program includes native games, a guided moccasin hike with native tea and crafts for kids.

Admission into one area provides free entry into the other areas on the same day.

Maple syrup products are available at both areas and pancakes and sausages are served at Mountsberg Conservation Area.
