have recently been asked. Question: I have heard that there is financial assistance for burial costs if your spouse was a veteran. Is this true?

Answer: To be eligible for burial by the fund, either within or outside Canada, the deceased must be a Canadian ex-serviceman or woman who meets the fund's financial criteria and has a record of active service during any of the following periods:

- First World War, from August 4, 1914 to August 14, 1921;
- Second World War, from September 1, 1939 to September 30, 1945;
- Korean War From July 15, 1950 to October 31, 1953.

The fund provides the services of a funeral director of the family's choice, a quality wooden casket and,

under certain circumstances, transportation expenses. The cost and standard of these services is set by an agreement between the funeral director and the fund.

The Last Post Fund also covers the cost of the cemetery plot, the opening of the cemetery plot, the opening and closing of the grave and cremation if desired.

It will also provide a suitable inscribed flat or upright military marker.

When a veteran dies, a branch office or representative of the fund MUST be contacted before any firm arrangements are made with the funeral director.
